

# Federal Fleet Report, Fiscal Year 2004

#### Dear Reader:

We are pleased to present the Federal Fleet Report for fiscal year 2004. We have reformatted the Report this year to provide a more detailed view of the Federal motor vehicle fleet. Vehicle categories are now defined as either passenger carrying vehicles or trucks. Passenger vans and sport utility vehicles are further defined within the light and medium passenger carrying classifications. Additionally, special purpose vehicles are now included in the Report. We have re-designed the Report's charts and graphs to provide more useful representations of trend data. Lastly, we have eliminated duplicate or outdated information from the Report.

The fiscal year 2004 Report was produced within our target period of four months after the close on the fiscal year on September 30<sup>th</sup>. This improved timeliness and the Report's re-design significantly increase the Report's value to Federal agencies as they continue to evaluate methodologies to increase the efficiency of their fleets.

The Federal Fleet Report is produced through the Federal Automotive Statistical Tool (FAST), an Internet-based system that collects fleet-related data from Federal agencies. FAST satisfies several distinct reporting requirements:

- The General Services Administration.....Federal Fleet Report
- The Department of Energy...... Alternative fuel vehicles and fuel use
- The Energy Information Agency.....Federal vehicle location data
- The Office of Management and Budget ...... Agency fleet budget submission

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# **Executive Summary**

#### Overview

Federal departments, agencies, and their contractors use motor vehicles to perform their missions. These vehicles, totaling more than 620,000 for fiscal year 2004, are obtained from three primary sources: agency purchase, lease from the GSA Fleet Program, or commercial lease. This report presents inventory, utilization, costs, and fuel use associated with the Federal motor vehicle fleet. The data in this report are summarized by:

- Overall Federal Fleet Profiles
- Inventory
- Cost
- Utilization
- Fuel

The data are also displayed by vehicle type, and in some instances, by location (foreign vs. domestic). Overviews of tabular data are also displayed in graphical charts for the current year and 5-year trends.

Privately-owned motor vehicles used by Federal employees on official business are not included in the Federal Fleet Report, nor are short term commercial rental vehicles (used less than 60 continuous days).

## **Background**

The Report summarizes statistical data by passenger-carrying vehicles, trucks, and all other vehicle types. Data are further summarized by characterizing each agency's vehicles by civilian, military and U.S. Postal Service, and in some instances, by vehicle source and location (domestic vs. foreign). Vehicle types identified in the Report include:

- Sedans and station wagons
- Passenger vans
- Sport utility vehicles
- Light trucks (4 X 2 and 4 X 4)
- Medium trucks
- Heavy trucks
- Ambulances
- Buses

## Significant Report Changes for Fiscal Year 2004

#### **Revised Report Format**

The Federal Fleet Report has been substantially unchanged for many years, apart from the occasional addition of new tables, charts, and graphs. We undertook a review to evaluate the value and relevance of all of the material in the Report, and developed a new format. Section 1 presents a high-level table summarizing each aspect of fleet operations: inventory, cost, use, and fuel. Each subsequent section provides additional data related to one of these primary subjects, using trend graphs and pie charts to illustrate most of the data tables. We invite your comments on the new format.

## Special Purpose and Emergency Vehicles

Special purpose and emergency vehicles were previously excluded from the Report. During the reformatting process, we could not identify a rationale for this exclusion. An interagency committee endorsed the decision to include such vehicles, even though this would show a sudden increase in fleet size from previous Reports. Approximately 20,000 special purpose and emergency vehicles are newly included in this report in the respective vehicle type and weight classification, adding substantially to the numbers of trucks.

#### Re-classification of Passenger Vehicles

There used to be a fairly clear distinction between passenger vehicles (sedans and station wagons) and trucks: passenger vehicles were used for transporting people and trucks were "work vehicles" for carrying tools, materials, supplies and equipment. In recent years this separation of use has become increasingly blurred. Policymakers and researchers may be interested to see the extent to which vehicles formally classified as trucks are used as passenger vehicles in the Federal fleet. Therefore, passenger vans and sport utility vehicles are grouped with passenger vehicles for purposes of this report. Buses and ambulances, while serving a "passenger carrying" role, are grouped into an "Other" category in the tables.

## Depreciation


Many Federal agencies do not recognize vehicle depreciation as an element of cost. Agencies that procure vehicles using appropriated funds generally expense the acquisition cost in the year of purchase. We appreciate the importance of fleet depreciation, however, and in previous versions of this Report have assigned a depreciation expense to each agency using a cost-per-mile depreciation factor provided by the GSA Fleet Program for each vehicle type (with the exception of the U.S. Postal Service, which reported its own depreciation). Recognizing that this approach ignores important differences in agencies' operations and replacement cycles, this year we asked each agency to calculate and report its own depreciation expense. We expect the reported data to improve in accuracy as agencies become more familiar with the depreciation concept.

#### Large Versus Small Fleets

In previous years, reporting agencies were separated into two categories: large agencies with at least 2,000 vehicles and small agencies having fewer than 2,000 vehicles. Small agencies reported only vehicle inventory statistics and were not mandated to report vehicle use, cost or fuel (although most small agencies voluntarily chose to report all four data elements). Starting with this year's Report, we have removed all distinctions between small and large agencies so that all Federal agencies operating vehicle fleets report the same data for inclusion in the Report.

### **Major Federal Fleet Trends**


Worldwide Motor Vehicle Inventory This chart shows the total Federal motor vehicle inventory reported by agencies into the FAST system. Until the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, the Federal inventory remained fairly constant. During fiscal years 2002 and 2003, law enforcement and military agencies increased their fleet size by approximately 13,000 vehicles in response to potential threats. Additional increases in fleet size were also reported in civilian agencies and the U.S. Postal Service (USPS) since fiscal year




2002. These increases are assumed to be related to increased accuracy of reported fleet data, and due to planned, strategic purchases for the USPS. The Office of Governmentwide Policy envisions that similar events may occur as more and more agencies acquire dedicated fleet management information systems, allowing them better control and reporting of data on vehicle assets.

## Motor Vehicle Acquisitions

These two charts summarize total motor vehicle acquisitions and acquisitions specifically for alternative fueled motor vehicles. As illustrated in the first chart. overall vehicle acquisitions have increased over this 5-year trend; however, fiscal year 2004 acquisitions have dropped slightly from fiscal year 2003 acquisitions. The upward trend in acquisitions is most likely related to increased missions related to national security and military support for the war in Iraq.




In contrast, acquisitions of alternative fueled motor vehicles (AFV) declined significantly during fiscal year 2004 (approximately 30 percent). There are many issues that may have caused this decline. First, many vehicle types usually used in law enforcement missions are not always available in AFV configurations (law enforcement activities were one of the key factors in fleet size expansion during the past few years). Secondly, the types of available AFVs in the vehicle configurations that Federal agencies use are declining. Most notably are vehicles fueled with compressed natural gas.



Finally, the financial constraints that Federal agencies operate under may make it difficult to purchase AFVs. These constraints include limited dollars to fund the incremental costs associated with purchasing AFVs and the decreased revenue associated with selling AFVs over conventionally-fueled vehicles.


#### **Total Fuel Consumption**

This chart shows the overall fuel consumption for the Federal fleet from fiscal year 2000 through fiscal year 2004. The upward spike in fuel consumption during fiscal vear 2003 can be attributed to increased missions associated with law enforcement and national security missions during that period. The downward trend exhibited during fiscal year 2004 is assumed to be an adjustment consistent with pre-fiscal year 2003 consumption levels and possibly the result of some agencies voluntarily reducing their petroleum consumption.




### Worldwide Miles Traveled

This chart shows the 5-year trend in worldwide miles traveled by Federal agencies. Agencies have reduced their use of motor vehicles since fiscal year 2002. This is in spite of an overall inventory increase during this same period. This disparity could be due to increased accuracy of agency data, and thus, the FAST system is appropriately showing corrections to previouslyreported data. However, we also believe that the reduction in usage could partially be due to accomplishments by some agencies in reducing petroleum consumption in response to Executive Order mandates.



#### **Worldwide Operating Costs**


The following chart shows the total worldwide operating costs associated with the Federal motor vehicle fleet between fiscal years 2000 and 2005. These costs include vehicle maintenance, fuel, depreciation. and overhead and indirect costs. Overall, total costs have declined by almost \$400M from fiscal year 2003. This decline may, in part, be due to decrease in fuel consumption by Federal agencies (see previous charts). However, as previously stated, a major factor included in operating costs is vehicle depreciation. Rather than using government-wide depreciation



factors for the entire Federal fleet, agencies reported their own vehicle depreciation numbers for the first time. Because many agencies do not have dedicated fleet management systems to track and calculate these cost elements, we believe the accuracy of Federal fleet depreciation for fiscal year 2004 is questionable, and possibly under-reported. We also believe that as more agencies deploy fleet management information systems, the accuracy of all reported data and the management of the fleet will improve significantly.

#### **FAST Data Trends**

As illustrated in the chart to the right, the consistency and dependability of data within the Report over the past five years is questionable. We base our conclusions upon the facts that many agencies do not have dedicated fleet management information systems, that some agencies have experienced key personnel losses, and that there have been several changes to the data requested over this period. Significant changes affecting this year's Report are the full implementation of OMB's fleet budget reporting through FAST and the reclassification of vehicle types within the reporting



structure. Of continuing concern is the difficulty in reporting alternative fuel consumption because of coding differences between the fuel providers and credit card merchants. However, we believe that the accuracy of data contained in the Report is improving each year as more agencies upgrade to automated fleet management information systems and as Federal fleet managers become better trained.


Passenger vehicles and trucks are broken down into their constituent vehicle types, as are law enforcement vehicles. Again, the passenger vehicle category now includes vehicles other than sedans and station wagons that are used primarily or exclusively to transport passengers, such as passenger vans and sport utility vehicles (SUV).

The division between light duty and medium duty for SUVs and passenger vans is a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 8,500 pounds, as specified in the Clean Air Act and the Energy Policy Act.



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
# **Chart 2-1: Worldwide Inventory Trends**





# **Chart 2-2: Vehicle Sources**







# **Chart 2-3: Domestic and Foreign Inventory**






Section 3 expands on the information provided in Table 1-2. FAST began collecting new types of cost data for FY 2004. For example, many agencies do not account for depreciation of fleet assets, so in prior years the depreciation expense reported by GSA Fleet (expressed as a cost per mile by vehicle type) was attributed to other agencies (excepting the U.S. Postal Service, which does account for depreciation). Beginning in FY 2004, all agencies are required to report vehicle depreciation as a separate expense.

Other costs collected and represented in this section include fuel, maintenance, indirect costs, commercial lease cost and GSA lease cost. Maintenance includes the cost of maintaining and repairing vehicles, including maintenance personnel, parts, supplies, and equipment. Indirect costs include management and overhead personnel, office supplies, building and utility costs, and any other costs that cannot be directly attributed to the operation or maintenance of vehicles. Commercial lease cost includes the lease charges paid to commercial leasing companies. GSA Lease cost is the total amount billed by GSA Fleet to its customer agencies, which includes fuel. Fuel costs for agency owned and commercially leased vehicles are not collected by vehicle type and are therefore shown as a single cost item in the Totals section in Table 3-2. All costs in this report are shown in U.S. Dollars.


This section also reveals some of the inconsistencies in the data that the agencies have reported through FAST. In some cases, it may not be possible to calculate the cost per mile, or miles per vehicle using the raw data from other tables in the report. The inconsistencies arise from agencies who have reported inventory and cost, but no miles, or miles, but no costs for certain vehicle types. In these situations, the data rows in the miles per vehicle and cost per mile tables for that agency and vehicle type will be blank.

# Chart 3-1: Cost Trends by Vehicle Type




Note: Chart 3-5, "Cost Per Mile – GSA Fleet" shows a significant discontinuity for the "Other" vehicles category (comprised of ambulances and buses) for FY2003 and FY2004. As additional cost detail for the GSA-leased portion of the Federal fleet has become available over the past two years, GSA Fleet has adapted the method by which the costs for individual vehicles are tracked and then summarized for use by the agencies in submitting data to FAST. We believe the FY2003 cost per mile drop shown on this chart is strictly a function of the method GSA Fleet used to calculate those costs, does not reflect an actual drop in costs, and has been resolved with the methodology now employed. The FY2003 cost per mile drop for these vehicles was not highlighted in the previous year's report for the sole reason that this trend and the other detailed cost per mile breakdowns within the fleet are new to the re-formatted version of the Federal Fleet Report for FY2004.

## Chart 3-4: Cost Per Mile – Agency Owned Vehicles















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
## **Chart 4-1: Mileage Trends**

## **Chart 4-2: Average Miles Per Vehicle**












## **Chart 5-2: Fuel Cost by Fuel Type**
