Global Goals

- 2001-2005 All plants cut emissions to air by 15%.
- All plants reduce fossil fuel usage by 10%.
- Top 7 plants reduce GHG emissions by 5% each of the five years of the plan.
- These goals were set with the help of external stakeholders and senior management.





Climate Leaders Initiative Key to Our Emissions Reduction Plans

- Partnership to help us learn about and plan for our GHG emissions reduction.
- U.S. Partnership leveraged globally.
- Motivation: our Climate Leaders Goal drove us to innovate, to make a business case for focussed action in reducing GHG emissions.





- For our full national Climate Leaders Goal, we set an aggressive 8% actual emissions reduction for total U.S. operations. (2000-2005).
- This entire goal will be met via our investment in an innovative co-generation project that produces electricity and process steam via a landfill gas powered turbine.






Multi-Million Investment to Make Renewable/Green Energy

- Use landfill gas to make electricity and steam at Waxdale.
- Install turbine to make 3,200 kW of electricity.
- Recover waste heat from exhaust to make 17,000 lbs./hr of plant steam at 150 psi.







Landfill Gas Green Energies Project Focus: For The Bottom Line

- Reduces Waxdale's fossil fuel use by 50%.
- Reduces Waxdale's GHG emissions by 47%.
- Delivers the total U.S. Climate Leader's goal of a 8% reduction.
