



Preserve America Summit Implementation **Progress Report**

Address security needs by developing guidance, including guidance on all-hazards risk assessment.

Lead Agency/Agencies: General Services Administration, Department of the Interior, Department of Defense, Department of Homeland Security

Summit Recommendation Progress: The team's task is to develop and implement a method of keeping and sharing existing guidance, information, and best practices for the integration of historic preservation and security requirements for buildings, cultural sites, and physical property, in general. The team is working with the existing Historic Preservation Learning Portal maintained by the National Park Service to house the Addressing Security Needs Clearinghouse. The Addressing Security Needs Bibliography developed by the Department of Defense-chaired Preserve America Summit panel has been added to the Portal in the Federal Preservation Institute (FPI) Bookshelf. The team has come to agreement with the NPS to more fully integrate Preserve America information, specifically the Addressing Security Needs bibliography into the Preservation Portal. GSA contributed \$15,000 to ACHP/NPS to facilitate this effort.

Next Actions: The Advisory Council is processing the paperwork to request transfer of the funds from GSA to the ACHP. ACHP will manage the transfer of funds to NPS for the work on the portal. Once the team receives notice to proceed from ACHP, we will work with NPS on a scope of work.
