How to Obtain a Waiver for a Certified 8(a) Firm to Compete Below the Competitive Threshold: Federal Agency Requirements

Federal Agency Request for Waiver, which includes:

- 1. Offer Letter, in accordance with 13 C.F.R. § 124.502(c);
- 2. An explanation of the Procuring Activity's determination that technical competitions are required or a large number of potential awardees exist, in accordance with 13 C.F.R. § 124.502(c);
- 3. The Agency's written commitment to continue to support the 8(a) BD Program Participants on a sole source basis below the competitive threshold. This explanation must include:
 - The last two most recent fiscal years' 8(a) contract dollars that were awarded by the Procuring Activity to 8(a) BD Program Participants on a sole source basis;
 - ii. The current fiscal year's forecast to award contracts to the 8(a) BD Program; and
 - iii. The result of any market research conducted by the Procuring Activity
- 4. Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS) Result of 8(a) Firms Performing Under the NAICS Code Assigned to the Respective Contract.
