UNITED STATES SENTENCING COMMISSION TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING ON COCAINE AND SENTENCING POLICY

- **WHAT:** U.S. Sentencing Commission Public Hearing titled "Cocaine and Federal Sentencing Policy 2006"
- **WHO:** The Commission will hear from representatives of law enforcement, the legal community, the judiciary, interested community groups, and the scientific community to address issues associated with federal cocaine sentencing policy.
