Scenic Site - 1979



Scenic site before any remediation. The site was described in the Consent Decree as located "about one mile north of the intersection of Highway 61 (Scenic Highway) and Brooklawn Road". It consisted of two generally identifiable areas of waste disposal and contamination: the Bluff Area, the primary area of disposal; and the Batture Area, a relatively small area of waste burial to the west of the Bluff Area.

Scenic Site - 1991



Cover was placed on top of the waste pit, and Baton Rouge Bayou was rerouted around the waste area. These remedial actions were implemented in response to a "Supplemental Remedial Action Plan" approved by the Court in 1989. No other remedial action has commenced at this point.

Scenic Site - 1997



Scenic Site after cap is in place and seeded with grass. Eleven potential recovery wells have been drilled. Recovery pumps to be installed in some of these wells for collection of contaminated ground water in 1999, as part of future remedial actions to be implemented.
