### Occupational Safety and Health Program

The purpose of this amendment is to transfer the Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Program from the Division of Ship Management (Office of Ship Operations) to the Office of Management Services and Procurement.

Accordingly, the basic order is revised as follows:

Revise section 6.01 to read as follows:

6.01 The Director, Office of Management Services and Procurement, shall be responsible for the overall planning, formulation, direction, and administration of the internal Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Program. The Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Manager (Safety Officer), located in the Office of Management Services and Procurement, shall be responsible for managing the Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Program in accordance with this order and the requirements of OSHA, DOT Order 3902.7 and applicable Maritime Administrative Orders.

Revise the introductory part of section 6.02 to read as follows:

6.02 The Maritime Administration Occupational Safety and Health Manager (Safety Officer) shall:

Revise section 9 to read as follows:

The Director, Office of Management Services and Procurement, Region Directors, Reserve Fleet Superintendents, and the Superintendent, U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, shall request funds for the Occupational Safety and Health Program in their budgets. Safety and health training, personnel needs and abatement of unsafe or unhealthful working conditions shall be identified and given adequate priority in developing annual budget submissions.
