SUBJECT

USER CHARGES

Section 1. Purpose:

This order assigns responsibilities for the establishment of fees and charges for special services performed for outside parties by the Maritime Administration.

Section 2. General:

Office of Management and Budget Circular A-25, "User Charges," and Order DOT 2510.1A set forth the basic policy that a reasonable charge should be made to each identifiable recipient for a measureable unit or amount of governmental service or property from which the recipient derives a special benefit. Circular A-25 provides criteria for determining the types of services for which fees are applicable and sets forth procedures for determining costs and setting fees.

Section 3. Responsibilities:

- 3.01 The Office of Management Services shall examine the services furnished by the Maritime Administration and recommend to the Maritime Administrator those services for which fees or charges should be imposed in accordance with Circular A-25. In addition, the Office of Management Services shall maintain and issue, as an Appendix of this order, an inventory of activities for which fees and charges have been established by statute or regulation.
- 3.02 <u>Associate Administrators, Office Directors, Region Directors, and the Superintendent, U.S. Merchant Marine Academy (Academy)</u> shall:
 - Recommend to the Maritime Administrator, through the Office of Management Services, the establishment of user charges for activities under their jurisdiction.
 - Ensure the user charge identifier (see appendix) is entered on each user charge document before forwarding to the Office of Accounting or the Academy's Department of Budget and Accounts for entry into the Departmental Accounting and Financial Information System (DAFIS).

- 3.03 The Office of Budget shall determine, except for fees imposed under Title XI of the Merchant Marine Act, 1936, as amended, the full cost of the work and services in accordance with the principles prescribed in Circular A-25 and recommend to the Maritime Administrator the amount of the fees or charges which should be imposed for such activities, including subsequent changes required to reflect changes in cost.
- 3.04 The Office of Accounting and the Academy's Department of Budget and Accounts shall ensure that the user charges received are entered into their respective accounting classification structure, in DAFIS.
