## The FRA Administrator's Declaration of Emergency Event

## **September 26, 2008**

Pursuant to Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 211.45, the Federal Railroad Administration's (FRA) Administrator, Joseph Boardman, has determined that as of September 26, 2008, the projected landfall of tropical storm Kyle on the coast of the United States and the potential of that storm to reach hurricane status, constitutes an "emergency event" as related to railroad operations. Therefore, the Administrator has activated the *Emergency Relief Docket* (FRA-2008-0009) as of September 26, 2008, and the emergency relief provisions of 49 CFR Section 211.45 are in effect.
