Promising Interventions: Preliminary Findings from the Amhara Region, Ethiopia

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## **The Context**

High national prevalence of child marriage in 2005

- 27% of girls aged 15-19 ever married
- 13% of girls 15-19 first married < 15 years

Low median age at first marriage for girls in Amhara Region

- Women 20-49: 14.2
- Men 25-54: 22.3

Negative implications for reproductive health, HIV/AIDS, STI, education, and gender-based violence

- **Types of Interventions** 
  - School-based
  - Community-based
  - Partnerships with national and regional legal/civil society organizations



# **School-Based Interventions**

Girls Advisory Committees (WL) - Male & female students - Teachers & parents - Primary school only	<ul> <li>Tackle problems of non-school attendance with PTA</li> <li>Provides support to girls to ensure school continuation</li> </ul>
Girls Clubs (PI) - Female students only - Primary & secondary schools	<ul> <li>Peer education on child marriage, HTPs, RH, life skills</li> <li>Support network for girls "escaping" early marriage</li> <li>Report planned child marriages to women's association &amp; teachers</li> <li>Promote community conversations at social gatherings (e.g. coffee ceremonies)</li> </ul>



### **Community-Based Interventions**

Woreda (District) Advisory Committee	<ul> <li>Campaigns against child marriage</li> <li>Intervenes with AWA to stop planned child marriages</li> </ul>
Amhara Women's Association (AWA)	<ul> <li>Organizes &amp; train Girls Clubs</li> <li>Provides scholarships for poor girls</li> <li>Sensitizes communities on early marriage consequences &amp; prevention</li> <li>Disseminates IEC materials</li> </ul>
Religious leaders	<ul> <li>PI organizes workshops for religious leaders: child marriage, HTPs</li> <li>Sign statements condemning child marriage</li> <li>Exhort religious bodies to advocate against child marriage in community</li> </ul>
Legal bodies	<ul> <li>Raise awareness of new legislation</li> <li>Enforce law</li> </ul>




### **Community-Based Interventions Cont'd**

Community-based Reproductive Health Agents (trained by PI)	<ul> <li>CBRHA sensitize against early marriage house-to-house</li> <li>Organize community gatherings</li> <li>Educate and mobilize at market places</li> <li>Intervene with AWA to stop planned child marriages</li> </ul>
Partnerships with National and Civil Society Organizations - Ethiopian Women Lawyers Association	<ul> <li>EWLA provides free legal counsel to victims of marriage by abduction and rape</li> <li>Works with PI to train law enforcement agencies</li> </ul>
- National Committee on Harmful Traditional Practices (EGLDAM)	<ul> <li>Develops training manual on early marriage, HTP, &amp; RH</li> <li>Provides material support to Girls clubs</li> <li>Promotes community conversations</li> <li>Develops and disseminates BCC materials</li> </ul>




### Percent Correctly Identifying Legal Minimum Age at Marriage by Message Exposure, Amhara EMES 2007






### Percent of Planned Marriages of Females Younger than Age 18 that Were Stopped, Amhara EMES 2007
