#### Travel and Construction Update

Beginning the morning of Wednesday, July 2, the Going-to-the-Sun Road will be fully open to public travel.

Expect up to 30-minute delays during nighttime construction (10 p.m. to 2 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. to 6 a.m.) on the west side of the road between the West Tunnel and Haystack Creek (3.5 miles). Even during non-construction hours, expect one-lane directional travel and a narrow corridor.


During the July 4th weekend (Thursday-Saturday) no nighttime delays will be in effect. The 4-hour delays will resume Sunday, July 6 at 10 p.m. Closure points will be at the West Tunnel and Haystack Creek.

The St. Mary Visitor Center is open, however construction continues on a small portion of the parking area.

All transit operations resume for this summer's season on July 3rd.

#### OTHER PARK ROADS

All other park roads are open, with the exception of parts of the Inside North Fork Road. Conditions can abruptly change. Please call 1-406-888-7800 for current information.
