




Chesapeake-Based Barge future implementation

- Will serve as mobile test platform




#### **Possible Barge Layout**

## Maritime Administration Recycling Program

- Since 1949, the Maritime Administration has been the recycling agent of U.S. government owned, merchant-type ships >1,500 gross tons
- The majority of obsolete ships are former U.S. Navy auxiliary, non-combatant ships and nonretention MARAD Ready Reserve Force Ships
- Ships awaiting recycling are moored at fleet sites in the James River, VA, Beaumont, TX and Suisun Bay in Benicia, CA

- Hull inspection data/report


## **Typical Hull Cleaning Equipment**


