## DECISION AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The parties to this action have submitted the Stipulation and Order which is attached and incorporated in this Order. The Grant Officer has revised his Final Determination, indicating that the sum of \$32,977.00 is presently due to the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration. Arizona Department of Economic Security agrees to pay \$32,977.00 to the U.S. Department of Labor within thirty days of signing the Stipulation and Order. The U.S. Department of Labor waives interest on the sum of \$32,977.00, unless these monies are not paid within the period specified.

The parties agree that an Order disposing of this matter shall be based solely on the Complaint and the settlement agreement between the parties.

Finally, Arizona Department of Economic Security withdraws its request for a hearing.

## Order

- 1. Arizona Department of Economic Security shall pay \$32,977.00 to the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration.
- Case No. 85-WPA-2, In the Matter of Arizona Department of Economic Security, is dismissed.

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WHEREAS, the United States Department of Labor (hereinafter the "Department") has audited grants held by the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES);

AND WHEREAS, the Grant Officer issued a Final Determination relating to Audit No. 09-4-061-03-39 on January 3, 1985, disallowing \$4,774,760;

AND WHEREAS, the Grantee appealed the Final Determination on January 18, 1985 and the case was docketed as Case No. 85-WPA-2;

AND WHEREAS, the parties desire to resolve the matter without the necessity of additional litigation;

THEREFORE, the parties hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

Subsequent to the audit referred to above, an additional audit was conducted which recommended that the disallowed amount be reduced to \$815,840. Offsetting of the 5. Payment under this agreement shall be made by a check made payable to the U. S. Department of Labor - ETA, and mailed to the undersigned attorney for the U. S. Department of Labor.

6. Given the foregoing, the Arizona Department of Economic Security withdraws its request for hearing in this matter, dated January 18, 1985.

7. Each party hereby agrees to bear its own fees and other expenses incurred by such party in connection with any stage of this proceeding.
