**DECISION AND ORDER APPROVING VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF
COMPLAINT**

Complainant, Jonathan Reynolds, alleges a violation of the employee protection provisions of 49 U.S.C. §4212 1 of the Wendell H. Ford Aviation Investment an Reform Act of the 21st Century (AIR 21) against Respondent, Trans State Airlines, Inc. Complainant requested a hearing before the Office of Administrative Law Judges after the Regional Administrator for the Occupational Safety & Health Administration dismissed his complaint.
