**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW
REQUEST FOR HEARING**

This matter arises under Title I of the Workforce Investment Act (WIA), 29 U.S.C. § 2801 et seq.; and the regulations issued at 20 C.F.R. § 667.800 et seq.

The Employment and Training Administration of the United States Department of Labor (Respondent) solicited applications for Grant SGA/DFA-PY 06-04 in the Federal Register on April 20, 2007. By letter dated June 29, 2007, (Respondent) informed Kentucky Farmworker Programs, Inc. (Complainant) that its application has been denied. On July 24, 2007, Complainant requested an administrative hearing on Respondent's decision before the Office of Administrative Law Judges (Office). This Office issued a Notification of Receipt of Request for Hearing and Prehearing Order on August 7, 2007. The parties were instructed to submit certain information to this Office.
