ORDER GRANTING STIPULATION FOR DISMISSAL

This matter arises under the Welfare to Work provisions of Title IV, Part A of the Social Security Act, 42 USC § 603(a)(5) and the implementing regulations at 20 C.F.R. Part 645.

On January 30, 2004, the Employment and Training Administration, U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) notified Complainant of a debt subject to collection in the amount of \$143,653.00 as a result of DOL's audit conducted after alleged violations of the above-mentioned Act and regulations. On February 20, 2004, Complainant filed a request for a hearing. This Office issued a Notification of Receipt of Request for Hearing and Pre-Hearing Order on March 17, 2004. Thereafter, the parties filed a Stipulation for Dismissal on November 29, 2005 stating that the parties have reached an agreement regarding the expenditures under the grant and all issues have been resolved.

Accordingly, as the parties have stipulated to the dismissal of this matter, it is **ORDERED** that this case be **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
