Groundwater Sampling and Community Meeting Highway 18 Perchlorate Site (Hills, Iowa)

SITE UPDATE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 7 will return to Hills November 30 - December 10, 2004. The purpose of the visit is to conduct groundwater and soil sampling. The EPA invites you to attend a community meeting on Wednesday, December 1, 2004, to find out about ongoing sampling efforts, various studies and progress concerning the project.

SAMPLING PROCESS

The EPA will conduct groundwater sampling for many residents who were previously above 4 parts per billion (ppb) of perchlorate, and residents who are currently on bottled water. There will also be soil and groundwater studies conducted west of the railroad tracks and south of Main Street.

QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSIONS

The Iowa Department of Public Health, the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry and EPA will be available at the community center December 1st from 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. and December 2nd from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. to respond to health questions and concerns from the community.
