3461. ● REPEAL OF 45 CFR PART 604, SUBPART F, AGENCY REPORTS

Abstract: The National Science Foundation will be deleting subpart F ("Agency Reports") of 45 CFR part 604, which requires the Director to submit a semiannual compilation on lobbying disclosures to Congress. This subpart also requires the Inspector General to perform annual evaluations of NSF's compliance with the requirements related to lobbying activity by its employees and submit these evaluations to Congress. The statute mandating the filing of these reports has been repealed, so subpart F no longer has any force or effect.
