"ROLL OF HONOR"

Soon after the war, Fort Donelson National Cemetery was established and the remains of 670 Union soldiers were reinterred here. These soldiers had been buried on the battlefield, in local cemeteries, in hospital cemeteries, and in near by towns. The large number of unknown soldiers-512-can be attributed to the haste cleaning up the battlefield and to the fact that Civil War soldiers did not carry government-issued identification. This list does not include the 512 unknown grave numbers.

NOTE

Names of the 62 men of the 11th Regiment Illinois Infantry killed at the Battle of Fort Donelson. These names partially obliterated were Copied from the original Head-board standing at the trench. The bodies were removed to the Cemetery and are interred in graves 1 to 62. (Graves were marked with UNKNOWN Head-stones.)
