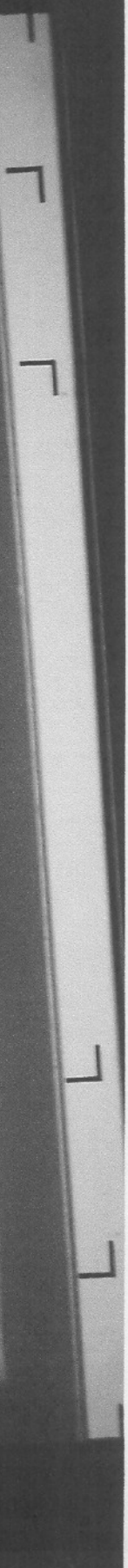


### BETTS CEMETERY, Pontotoc Co., MS

This is an old cemetery on Highway 41 just east of the Natchez Trace. You have to turn in a logging road that goes up to the Abernathy Gas Well.
