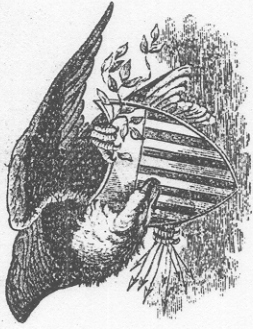

The Commanding Officer of the eighth Wisconsin Battery of Light Artillery

TO ALL WHO SHALL SEE THESE PRESENTS, GREETING:

Know Ye That, reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of *Amos R. Watkins* I do hereby appoint him *Corporal* in 8th Battery of the Wisconsin Light Artillery in the service of the UNITED STATES, to rank as such from the *First* day of *January* one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty*. He is therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of *Corporal* by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all *Non-commissioned Officers* and *Soldiers* under his command to be obedient to his orders as *Captain of Cavalry*. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions, from time to time, as he shall receive from me, or the future Commanding Officer of the *Battery*; or other *Superior Officers* and *Non-commissioned Officers* set over him, according to the rules and discipline of *War*. This Warrant to continue in force during the pleasure of the Commanding Officer of the *Battery* for the time being.

GIVEN under my hand, at the *Head Quarters* of the *Battery*, at *Madison, Wisconsin*, this *First* day of *January* in the year of our *Lord* one thousand eight hundred and *Twenty*.
