

prisoner at Mafusburg Augt 7<sup>th</sup> 1862 and now in confinement at  
the military prison at Mafusburg I do hereby solemnly swear that  
I will bear true faith, allegiance and loyalty to the United States and all military  
organizations hostile to the United States, and do solemnly swear  
that I will support, protect and defend the Constitution and Gov-  
ernment of the United States against all enemies, whether domestic  
or foreign; that I will bear true faith, allegiance and loyalty to the  
same, any ordinance, resolution or law of any State Convention or  
Legislature to the contrary notwithstanding; and further, that I  
will well and faithfully perform all the duties which may be required  
of me by the laws of the United States. And I take this oath  
freely and voluntarily, without any mental reservation or evasion  
whatever, with a full and clear understanding that death, or other  
punishment by the judgment of a Military Commission, will be the  
penalty for the violation of this, my solemn oath and pledge of honor.  
And I also swear, that, under no consideration, will I go beyond  
the military lines of the United States forces.
