Inventory of the effects of Henry C Edwards late  
a Private of Captain F. J. Edwards Company B of  
the 74 Regiment of Ohio Volunteers, who was enrolled as  
a Private at Xenia in the State of Ohio on  
the 27 day of January 1862, and mustered into the service of the United  
States as a Private on the 27 day of Jan 1862, at Xenia  
in Company B, 74 Regiment of Ohio Volunteers, to serve Three  
years or during the war; he was born in Warren Co in the State  
of Ohio; he was 20 years of age, 6 feet        inches  
high, light complexion, gray eyes, light hair, and by occupation, when enrolled,  
a Farmer; he died in 8th Ohio Field Hospital, at  
Stone River on the 6 day of February 1863, by  
reason of Wounds
