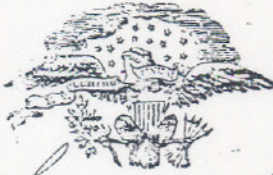

Mead of the 38th Regiment of United States at Atlanta, Illinois on the 16th day of August 1861, to serve 3 years; he was born in Randolph Co. in the State of Indiana is 23 years of age, 5 feet 11 inches high, light complexion, blue eyes, light hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Carpenter. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days.* Because of Gunshot wound of right arm received at the battle of Stone River, Sep 31st 1862 - He has done no duty since.

I certify that I have carefully examined the said Isaac Fleming of Captain W. G. Whitehurst's Company, and find him incapable of performing the duties of a soldier because of a Gunshot wound right arm - The arm was raised & the fore arm flexed and pronated; the ball entered the fore arm midway on the ulnar side passed out in front two inches below the elbow entered the arm two inches above the elbow on the inside of the biceps made its exit posteriorly at the middle of the arm - the wound is healed, the forearm flexed at right angle, muscles rigid and contracted, motion of hand limited.
