

CIVIL WAR SOLDIERS

Mertice Collins and I drove the monotonous drive to Jackson, Mississippi one week-end. Confidant I would bring home loads of information to publish in the Settlers. Wrong! The records I sought - Civil War Pension Applications of Soldiers from Itawamba County - were not to be found. In fact, they could only be obtained by tiring labor. We could only find a WPA account of soldiers who fought from Itawamba County. This work was copied from Applications in the court-house at Fulton. It is no longer there - as far as I am concerned. I have look'd everywhere for it to no avail. This list will have to suffice for the time being anyway. The archives does have the actual records on film and you can order the war record as well as pension record from them. They do suggest you order the war record itself from Washington. The pension record from the state. While Mertice copied soldiers, I tackled the newspapers. It was a disaster. After much reading of the film - I only had three obituaries. This from a 1902 paper - the earliest. I felt I simply could not afford to drive three hours for such low production. I therefore shifted my efforts into other areas. At any point, here are the results of our day at the archives.

In 1861, 3 Companies were made up in Eastern Itawamba. They were: Bullards, Toomers, and Benson's. Jasper N. Chaffin was Lt. of Benson's. Listed below and on the following pages are the known soldiers serving from Itawamba Co., Ms.
