Matthews, and was honorably Discharged at Victoria Texas on the 3 day of Oct, 1865; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 39 years; height, 5 feet 9 inches; complexion, light; hair, light; eyes, hazel. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Don Carlos Battle in the State of Texas, on or about the 31 day of Dec 1862, he was injured or by selection

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. *240,560*, and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office that *Israel Vanscover* was enrolled on the *18* day of *Sept*, 1861, at *Spring Mountain, O.* in *Co. I*, *51* Regiment of *Ohio* Volunteers, to serve *3* years or during the war, and mustered into service as a *Private* on the *9* day of *Oct*, 1861, at *Canal Dover, O.*, in *Co. I*, *51* Regiment of *Ohio* Volunteers, to serve *3* years, or during the war. On the Muster Rolls of *Co. I*, of that Regiment, for the months of from muster in to December 31, 1862, he is reported Present. *July* & *July* 13, Absent, wounded in action on *Stone River, Tenn. July 2, 1863*, in hospital at *Louisville, Ky.* (He was in action at battle of *Stone River, Tenn. July 2, 1863*.) Subsequent rolls to *Oct 31, 63*, report him Absent in hosp. at *Camp Sumner, O.* (Rolls from *Oct 31, 63* to *June 30, 64*, and roll for *Sept & Oct 64*, are not on file.) Re-enlisted as a *Vth. 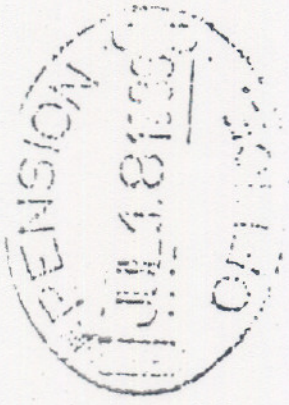
