YOU ARE LOOKING AT A COPY OF THAT "LIKENESS". CAPT. WEBB WAS WOUNDED AT YOUR BATTLEFIELD AND LATER DIED FROM THOSE WOUNDS. THANK YOU AGAIN FOR THE COPY OF THE DIARY, PLEASE ADD THIS PICTURE TO YOUR MICHIGAN FILE.
