

Campe of 70th OV Vols Company A in the Rifles near the Basis of Kinesaw  
Montan

Teusday June 28th 1864

Father and Brother I will try and write you a few lines this eavning  
well we have been in a very hard fight for three days. Second Division  
of our coprs commanded by Morgan L. Smith and Second Brigade of our  
Division and a detail of First Division maid a charge on the montain  
and was repused with a very heavy loss. Rebles more than poud in canister  
and grape shots into our men cut our men down as fast as they came up.  
the rason why we was not out we was out the day before but shell busted  
all around us and over us we are looking for to have to make a charge  
yet to night - cannot chase it in day time on account of being so hot -  
that was one reason why it was not take yesterday the montain is one  
mile to the top the way we have to go and very steepe it is a hard  
dose. there can't a man of us put up our head hear in daytime without  
being shot at. I can't write any more. At prasant. I want you one's to  
send me some enveops and writting paper for we can't get any hear now.  
George I want you to send me two pounds of tobaco chewing tobaco it will  
cost 18 cents postage by mail tell me how much it cost you so I can pay  
you the money I would like to have it before we get in to camp send it  
as soon as you can I want you to write soon. The weather is very hot

Camp of 90<sup>th</sup> O.M. & Company in the High  
near the Basis of Kincaid Mountain

Tuesday June 28<sup>th</sup> 1864.

Father and Brother I will try and write you  
a few lines this evening well we have been in a very  
hard fight for three days. Second Division of our Corps  
Commanded by Morgan & Smiths and Second  
Brigade of our Division and a detail of Forest  
Division made a charge on the mountain and was  
repulsed with a very heavy loss. Rebels more than four  
times as many as we were. They shot us down as fast as they  
could. The reason why we were not out the day before  
but still trusted all around us and over us we are looking  
for to have to make a charge yet to night cannot  
discharge it in day time on account of being so hot  
that - was one reason why it was not - take by water do  
the Mountain is one mile to the top the way we have  
up and is very steep it is so steep there cant  
a man of us put up our head bearing daylight without  
being shot at I cant write any more  
at present I want you to send me some  
envelopes and writing paper for me cant get any  
here now. George I want you to send one two pounds  
of ~~Tobacco~~ Chewing tobacco it will cost  
18 cents postage by mail tell me how much it  
cost you so I can pay you the money I would like  
to have it before we get in to camp send it as soon  
as you can I want you to write soon
