ACTION REQUESTED: Board approval of a joint notice of proposed rulemaking with the Federal Reserve Board and Office of Thrift Supervision to provide clarification regarding aspects of the final unfair or deceptive acts or practices (UDAP) rule issued in December 2008. 15 U.S.C. 57a(f)(1); 74 FR 5498 (January 29, 2009).

SUMMARY: This is a jointly proposed rulemaking involving NCUA, the Office of Thrift Supervision, and the Federal Reserve Board (collectively, the Agencies) to provide clarification regarding aspects of the final UDAP rule issued in connection with consumer credit card accounts. <u>See</u> 74 FR 5498 (January 29, 2009). To facilitate compliance with the final UDAP rule, the Agencies propose to amend specific portions of the regulations to address deferred/waived interest credit card programs and the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, and to provide additional examples in the official staff commentary.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Board approve the joint proposed rule.
