Background: The CPWG has received numerous complaints from the cross-certified entities and applicants regarding the requirement in Section 5.5.4 to backup the archive. In practice, the archive is not backed up by the FPKI Management Authority, nor must it be backed up by the cross-certified entities. This is an erroneous requirement unless specified by the cross-certified entity's own certificate policy.

Change summary: This Change Proposal would eliminate the current text in Section 5.5.4: Archive Backup Procedures, and add an optional clause.

Specific Changes: This Change Proposal would eliminate Section 5.5.4., as shown below. Text with strikethrough will be removed. <u>Underlined</u> text will be added.

5.5.4 Archive Backup Procedures

The CPS or a referenced document shall describe how archive records are backed up, and how the archive backups are managed. If a cross-certified entity chooses to back up its archive records, the CPS or a referenced document shall describe how the records are backed up and managed.
