

**Federal PKI Steering Committee Meeting
December 11, 2002**

Federal PKI Steering Committee (FPKISC) Status:

The DOE representative to the FPKISC was unable to brief us on the specifics of their document digital signature validation application due to inclement weather. However, she will brief the FPKISC in the near future.

Judith Spencer distributed to the group the following: the Federal PKI Governance diagram, the Federal Digital Credential (PKI) Governance (Federal Agencies Only) diagram, the E-Authentication Governance diagram, Draft - A white paper on simplifying the Federal PKI, and the Federal PKI Steering Committee Response to the Recommendation of a Hierarchical, or Root, PKI for the Federal Government. All were discussed to provide background and a vision for the future. Judy will email the FPKISC Bill Burr's "Draft - A white paper on simplifying the Federal PKI" for comments.

A Citizen & Commerce Certificate Policy Version 0.2, December 3, 2002 document was created for authenticating citizens and commercial enterprises for electronic services via the e-Authentication gateway as well as provide a provisional OID for agency interoperability with the FBCA. The Citizen & Commerce CP was approved by the Federal PKI Policy Authority membership at the December 10th meeting. NIST will be adding verbiage and an additional OID to this CP for pseudo anonymous names.
