### *HIPAA and Other Health Laws: Nevada Compliance Assistance Seminar*

**WASHINGTON--**The Compliance Assistance Seminar sponsored by the U. S. Department of Labor's Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) and the Nevada Department of Insurance, will take place in Las Vegas, Nevada, on April 28-29, 2004 at the Tropicana Hotel and Casino, 3801 Las Vegas Blvd., Las Vegas, Nevada.

The Nevada seminar is the 22<sup>nd</sup> in a series of ongoing seminars sponsored by the Labor Department under its Health Benefits Education Campaign (HBEC).
