MEDIA ADVISORY HIPAA and Other Health Laws: Delaware Compliance Assistance Seminar

PORTLAND--The Compliance Assistance Seminar sponsored by the U. S. Department of Labor's Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) and the Maine Division of Insurance, will take place in Portland, Maine, Oct. 13-14, at the Double Tree Hotel, 1230 Congress St.
