**ERRATUM**

By the Chief, Mass Media Bureau:

1. This action further extends the period before the effective date for all of the rule amendments adopted in the *Memorandum Opinion and Order (Memorandum)*<sup>1</sup> in MM Docket No. 87-121 (FCC 91-273), adopted August 28, 1991, and released on September 17, 1991. The *Memorandum* responded to petitions for reconsideration, reaffirming the Commission's earlier decision to allow routine short-spaced FM broadcast station assignments, and adopting several petitioned refinements to the rules.

2. The period before the effective date is extended again to allow the appropriate time between the date the rules were published in the Federal Register and their effective date. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT the effective date of the amendments to 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.207, 73.215, and 73.316 IS AMENDED to December 19, 1991.

3. This action is taken pursuant to authority found in Section 4(i) and 303(r) of the Commissions Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.24(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules (47 CFR Sections 0.24(b) and 0.283).
