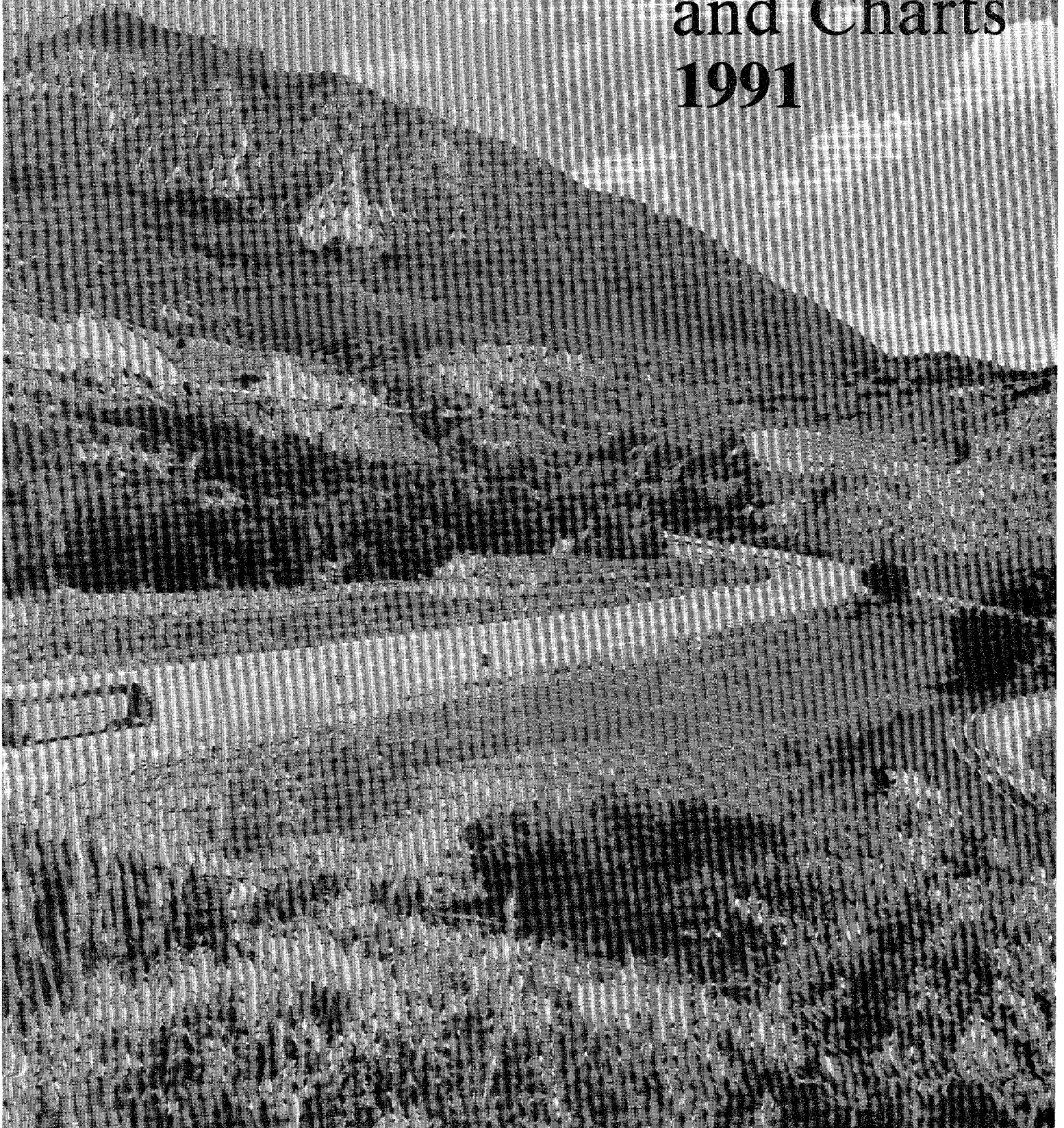

## SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS AND CHARTS - 1991

### **MOTOR FUEL** - Highway Use of Gasoline Down 1.5 Percent; Special Fuels Use Down 2.6 Percent

Highway use of motor fuel in 1991 totaled 128.6 billion gallons, a decrease of 1.6 percent from 1990. In 1992, highway use of motor fuel is expected to increase by about 2.7 percent. Net State motor-fuel tax revenues increased by 7.1 percent from 1990, reflecting a number of tax rate increases in 1991. State motor-fuel tax revenues are expected to increase 4.3 percent in 1992 reflecting increases in both fuel consumption and tax rates.

The gasoline tax rate changed in 23 States during 1991. Fourteen of the changes were legislated increases. The remaining nine States have variable rate taxes which are adjusted at regular intervals based on changes in the average wholesale price of gasoline, the consumer price index, or another indicator as specified in the State tax law.

### **MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS** - Total Motor-Vehicle Registrations Decrease Nearly 426 Thousand in 1991

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation decreased from 188,797,914 in 1990 to 188,371,935 in 1991, a decrease of 0.2 percent. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues increased 4.7 percent. Motor-vehicle registrations for 1992 are expected to exceed those in 1991 by 0.7 percent for a total of 189,694,000. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues are expected to increase by 0.5 percent in 1992.

### **DRIVER LICENSING** - Number of Licensed Drivers Up 1.2 Percent

The total number of licensed drivers has increased from 167.0 million for 1990 to 169.0 million for 1991—a 1.2 percent increase. Although the middle-age group (age 40-44) shows a large increase in drivers compared to 10 years ago (53 percent), the most drastic increase for the same period of time is still in the older drivers group (70 and over—59.2 percent).

### **HIGHWAY FINANCE** - Total Highway Expenditures Increased by \$3 Billion in 1991

Highway-user imposts, consisting of motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls, increased by \$4.1 billion from 1990 to 1991. Those revenues totaled \$48.8 billion and accounted for 60.1 percent of total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1991. Total receipts were \$81.2 billion, an increase of \$5.9 billion over 1990. Receipts from nonuser sources—general fund revenues, property taxes, investment income and miscellaneous receipts—totalled \$26.1 billion, a 2.7 percent increase from 1990. Bond proceeds for 1991 were \$6.3 billion, an increase of \$733 million from 1990.

Total highway expenditures amounted to \$78.3 billion in 1991, up \$2.9 billion from 1990. Capital outlay increased by \$1 billion, or 2.9 percent, to \$36.2 billion. The lack of inflation in 1991 highway construction prices reduced the increase in real expenditures to 3.8 percent for highway capital outlay. Expenditures for highway maintenance and traffic services amounted to \$20.4 billion, an increase of \$55 million, or 0.3 percent; however, real maintenance expenditures increased by 3.1 percent over 1990 level.

For the 50 States and the District of Columbia, highway-user imposts accounted for 77.5 percent of the \$41.2 billion in State highway receipts for 1991. State highway receipts from user fees increased by \$1 billion while receipts from nonuser sources declined by \$461 million. Nonuser sources accounted for 13.2 percent of State receipts for highways. Bond proceeds totaled \$3.8 billion, an increase of \$609 million from 1990. Bond proceeds exclude refunding. State highway programs totaled \$47.6 billion (excluding grants-in-aid to local governments) for 1991, an increase of \$2 billion over 1990. Highway capital outlay—\$27.1 billion—accounted for 57 percent of total State highway expenditures.

### **ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL** - Travel Up 1.3 Percent

Public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1991, totaled approximately 3.89 million miles, an increase of 0.2 percent from 1990.

Highway travel in the United States increased to an estimated 2,172 billion vehicle-miles—an increase of about 1.3 percent from 1990.

The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 23 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 11 percent of the mileage and carry 71 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 87 percent of the travel.

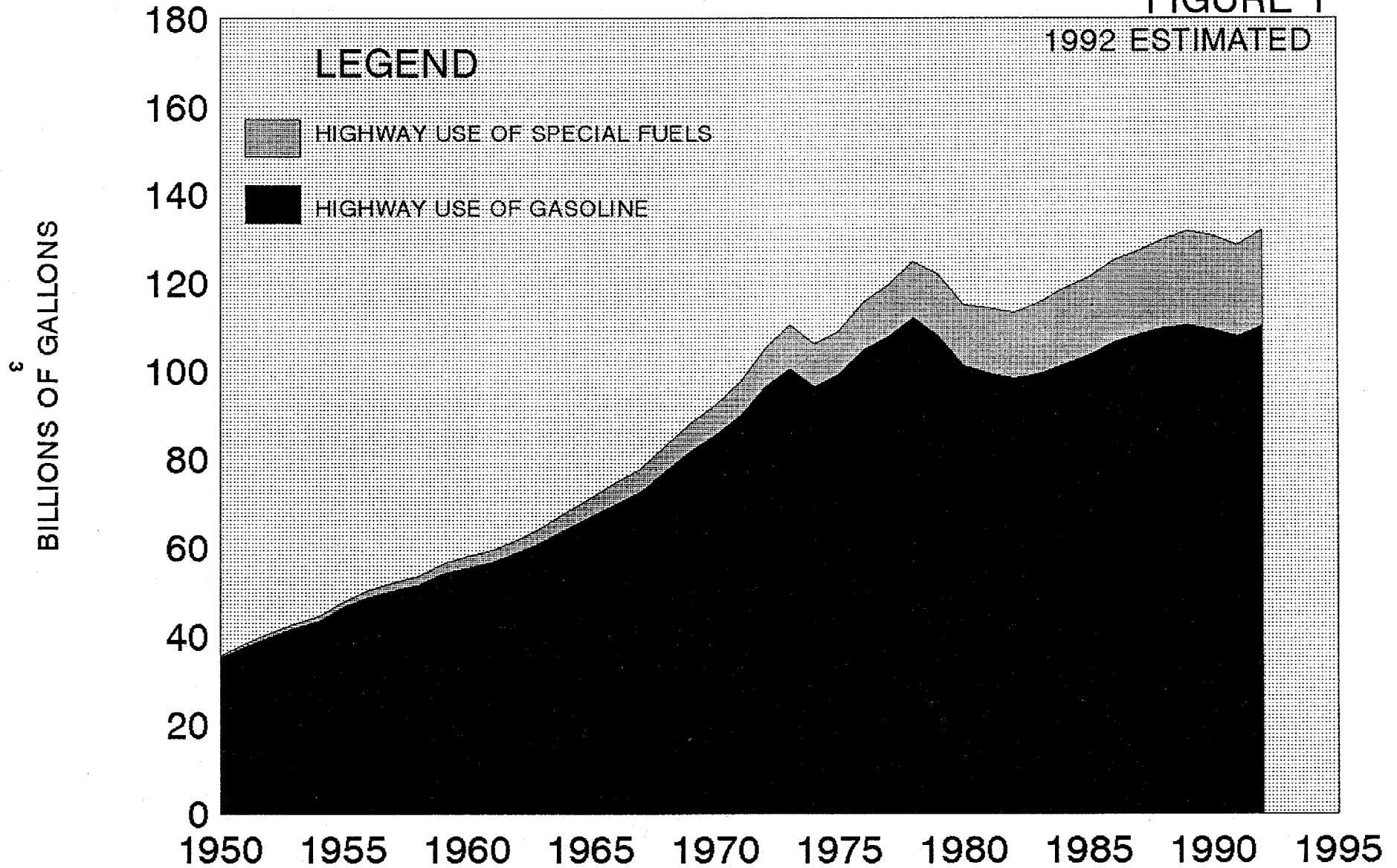
Congestion on the urban Interstate System has steadily become worse. In the period 1981 to 1991, the percentage of mileage affected during the peak travel hour increased from 25 percent to 47 percent. In the same period, the percentage of peak hour vehicle-miles affected increased from 49 percent to 70 percent.

**MISCELLANEOUS** - Expenditures per mile averaged \$30,370 and \$8,800 for capital outlay and maintenance, respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle-miles of travel averaged \$17.55 for all States.

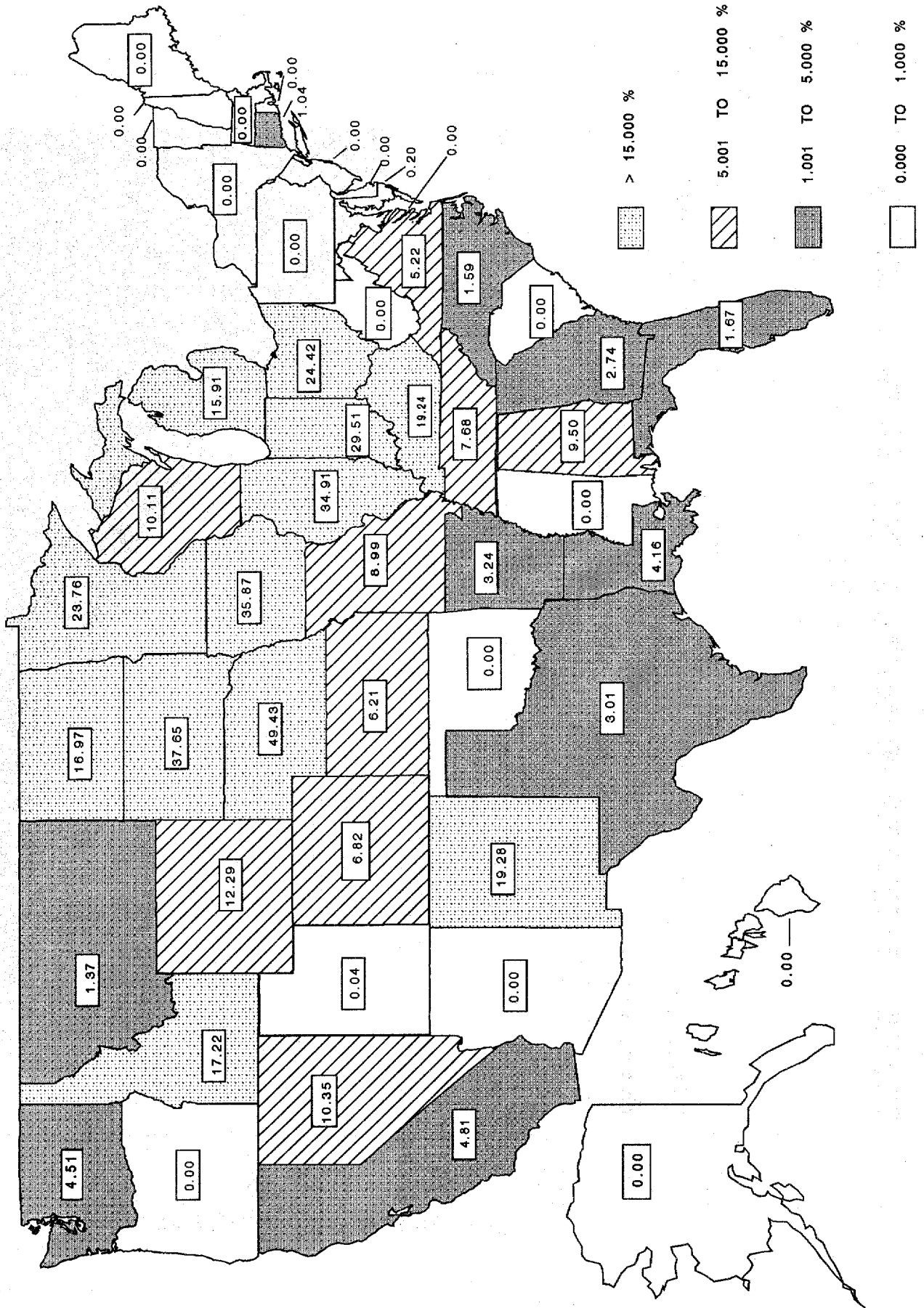

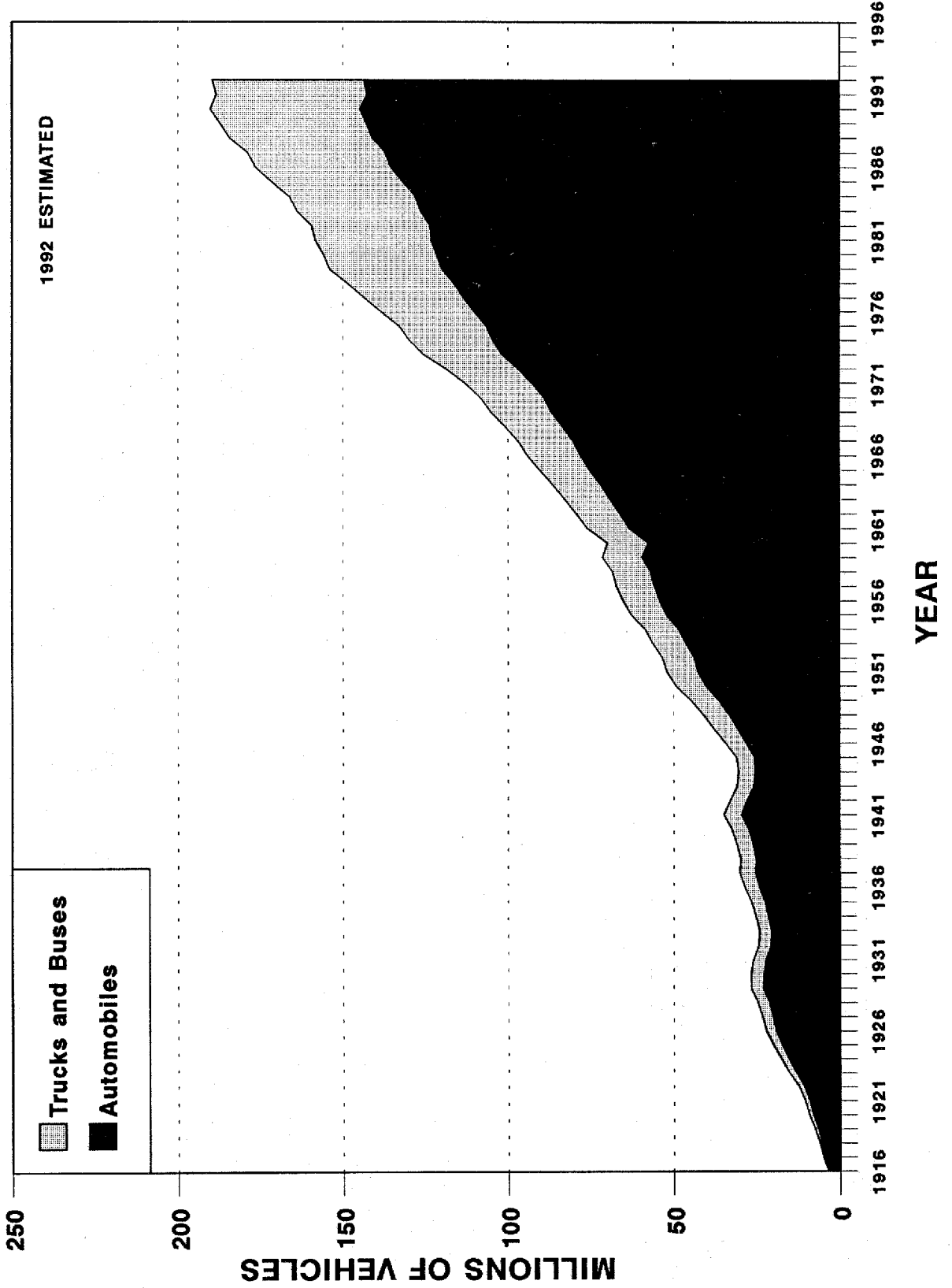
GASOLIN AS A PERCENT OF HIGHWAY USE OF GASOLINE - 1991

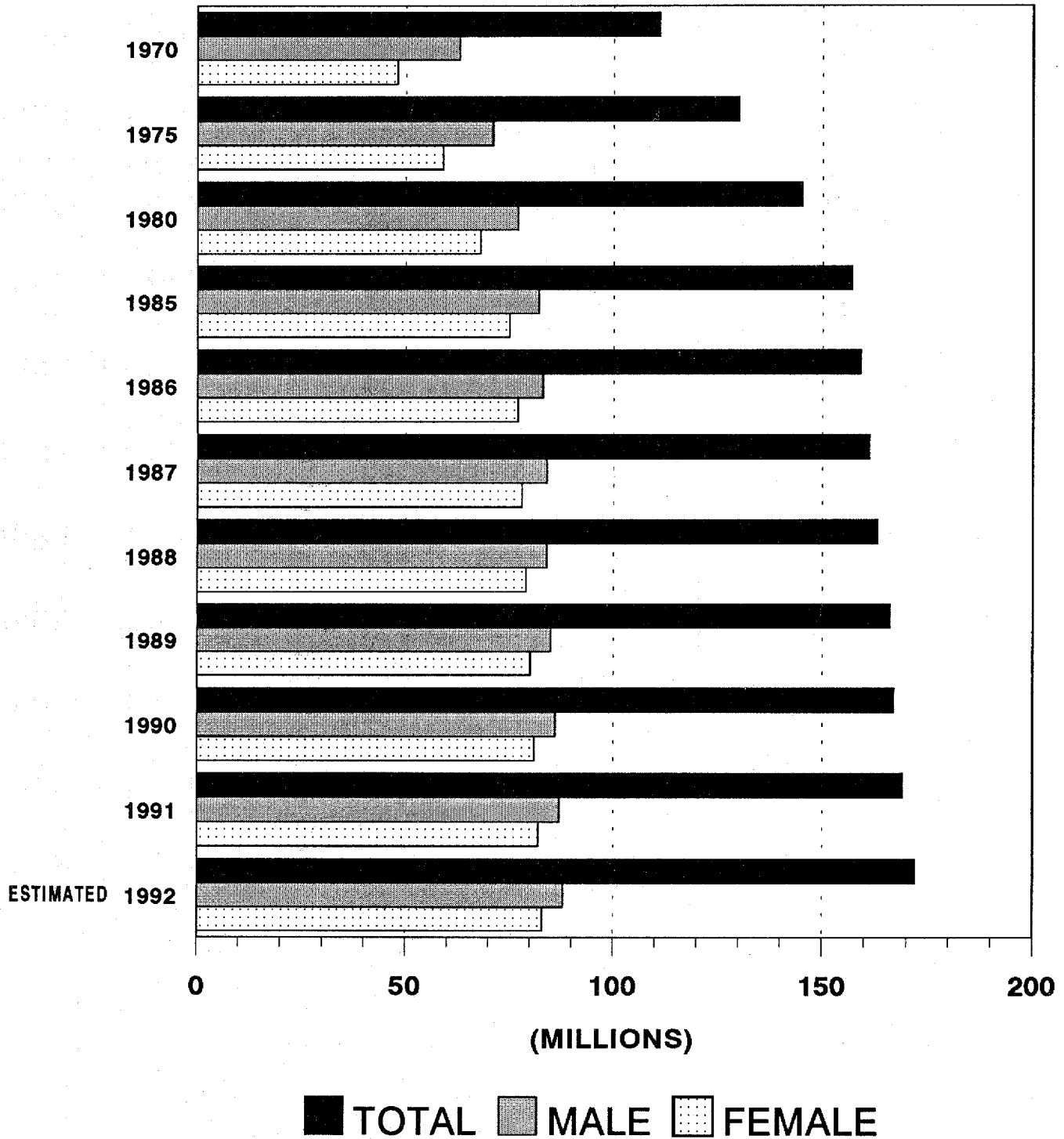

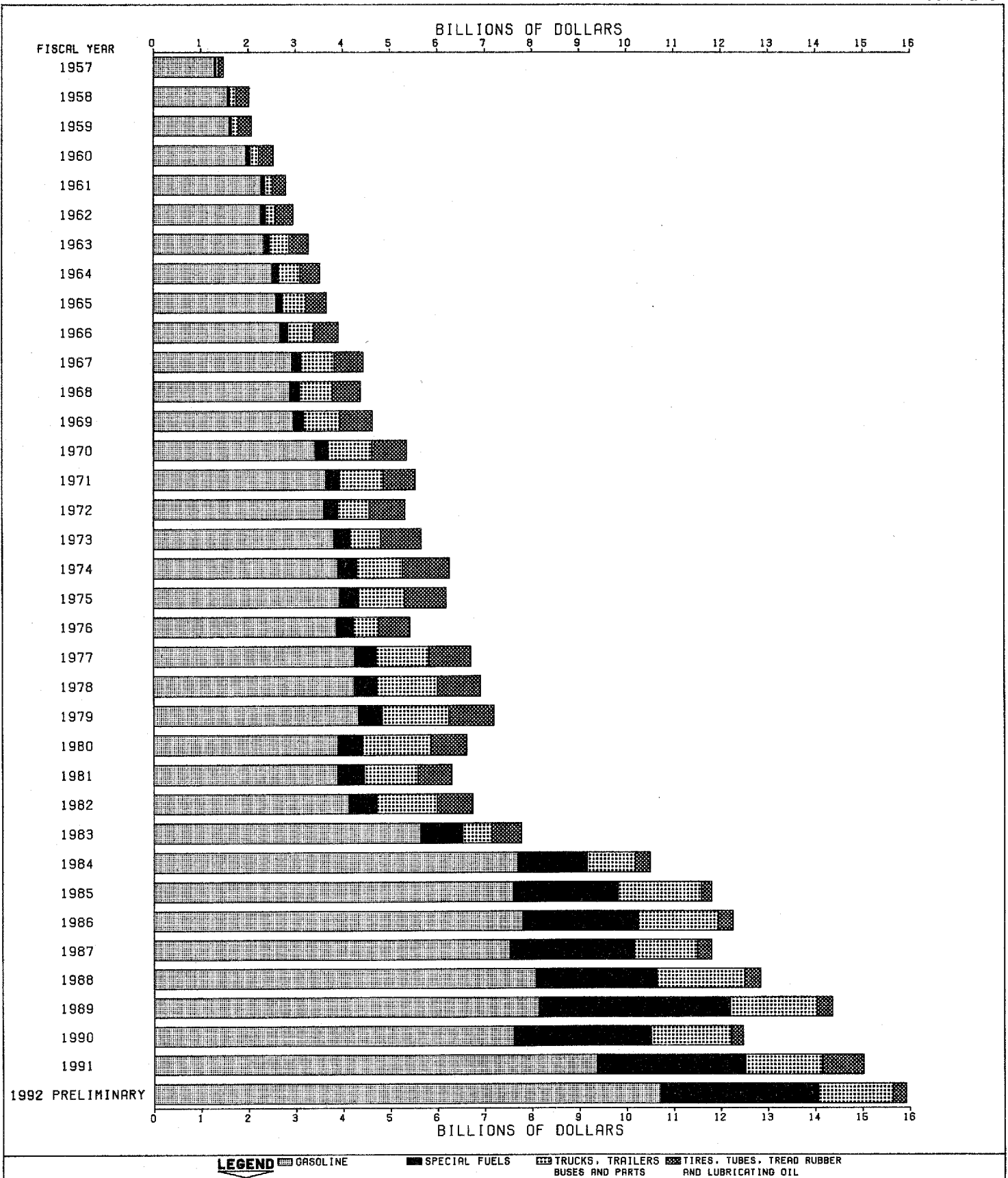

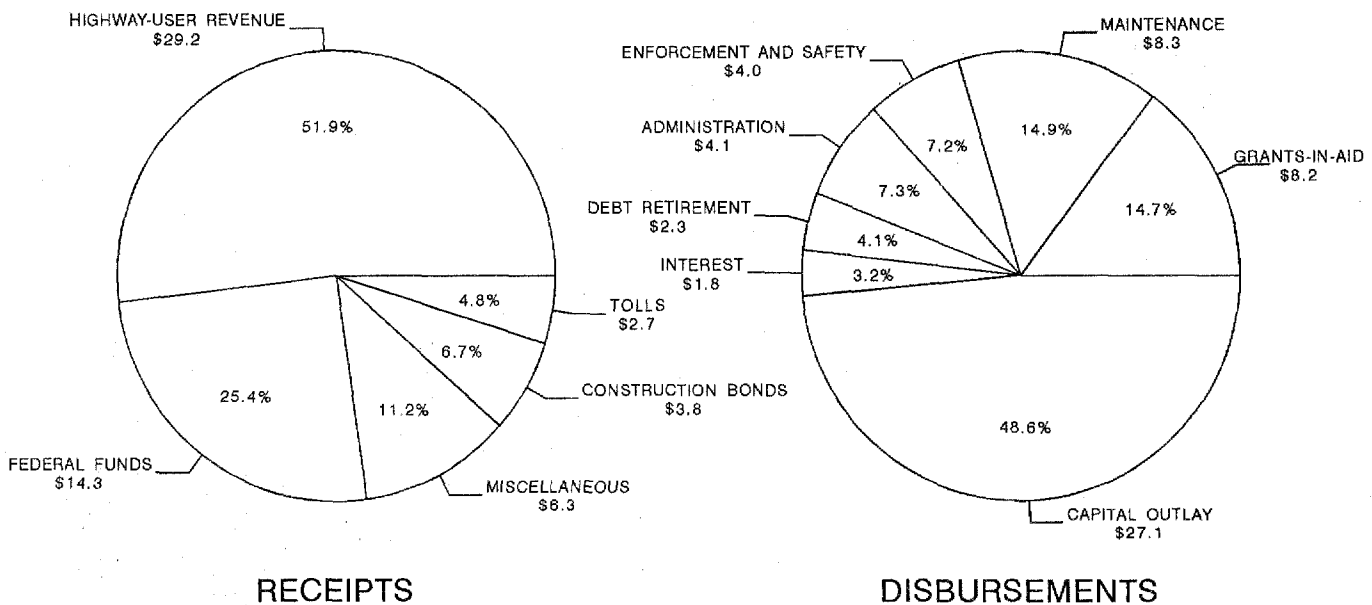

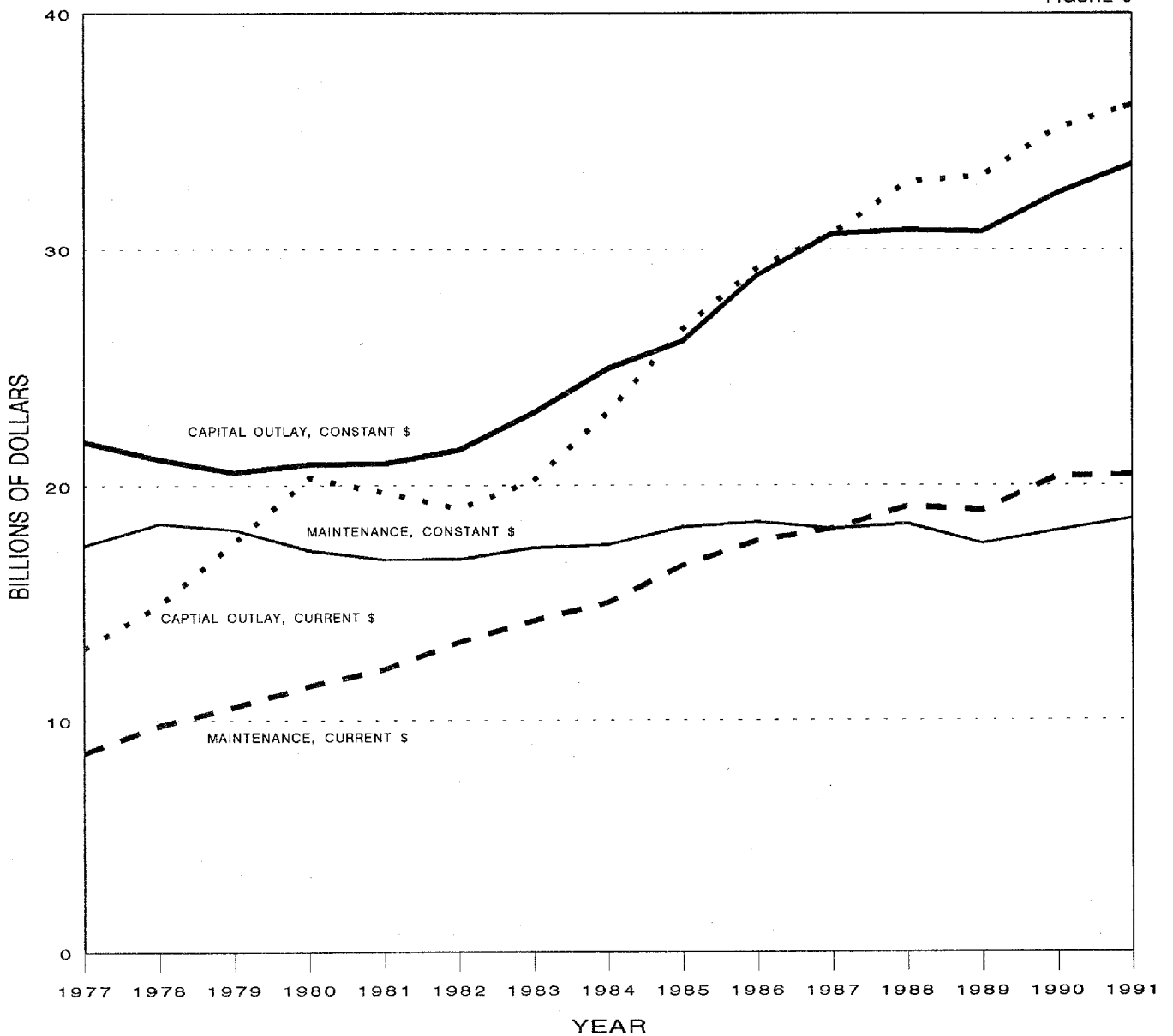

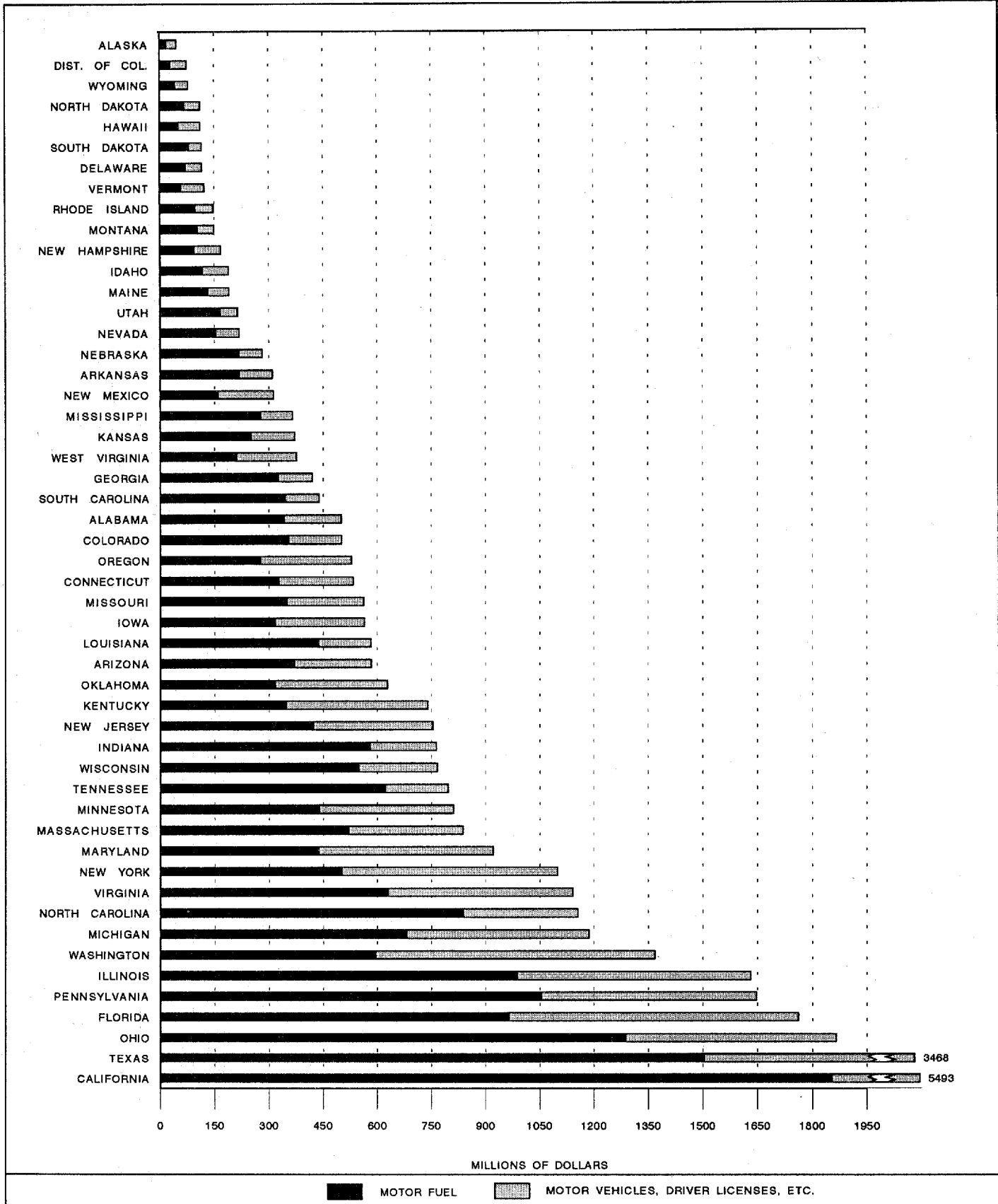

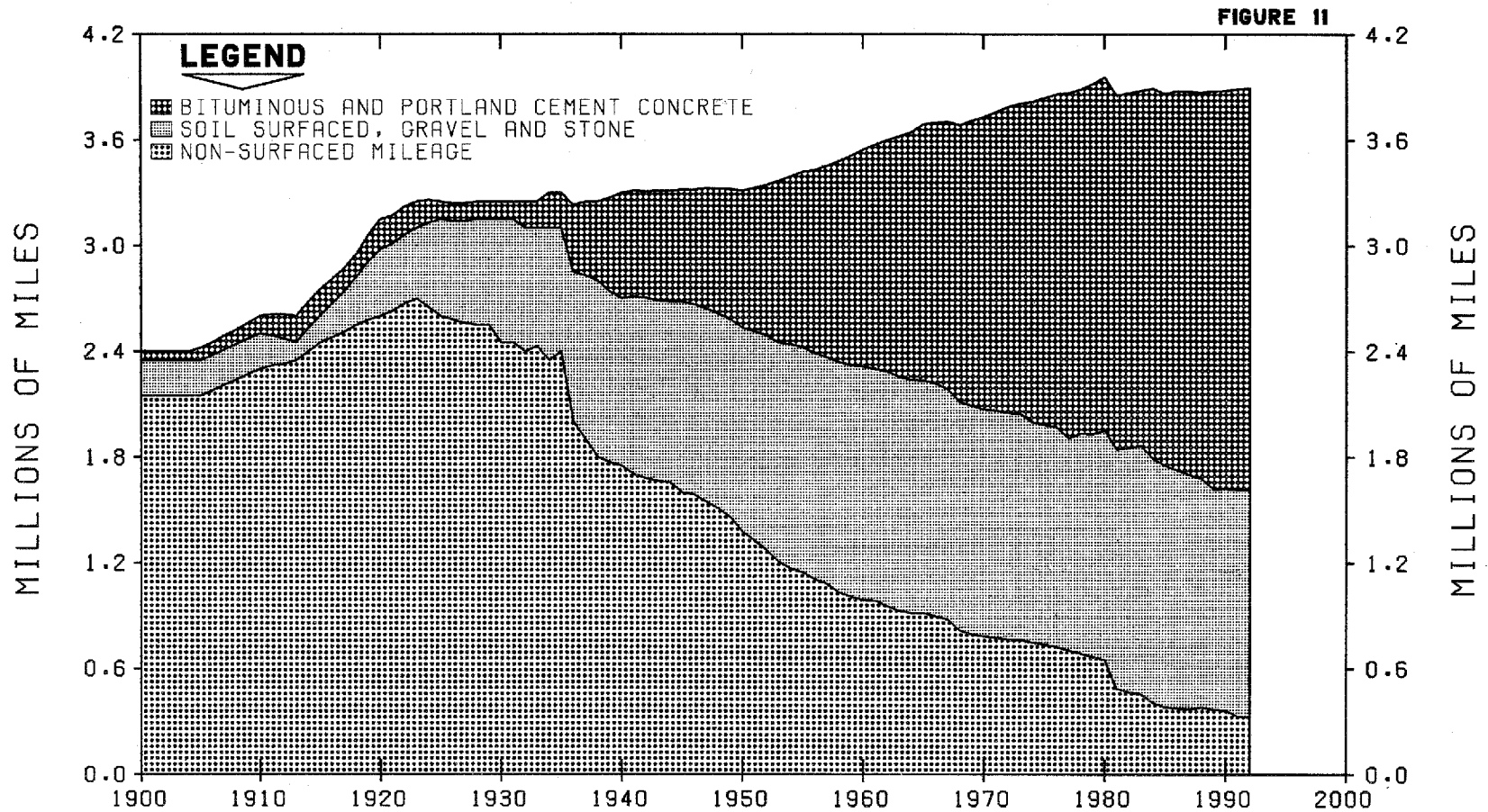

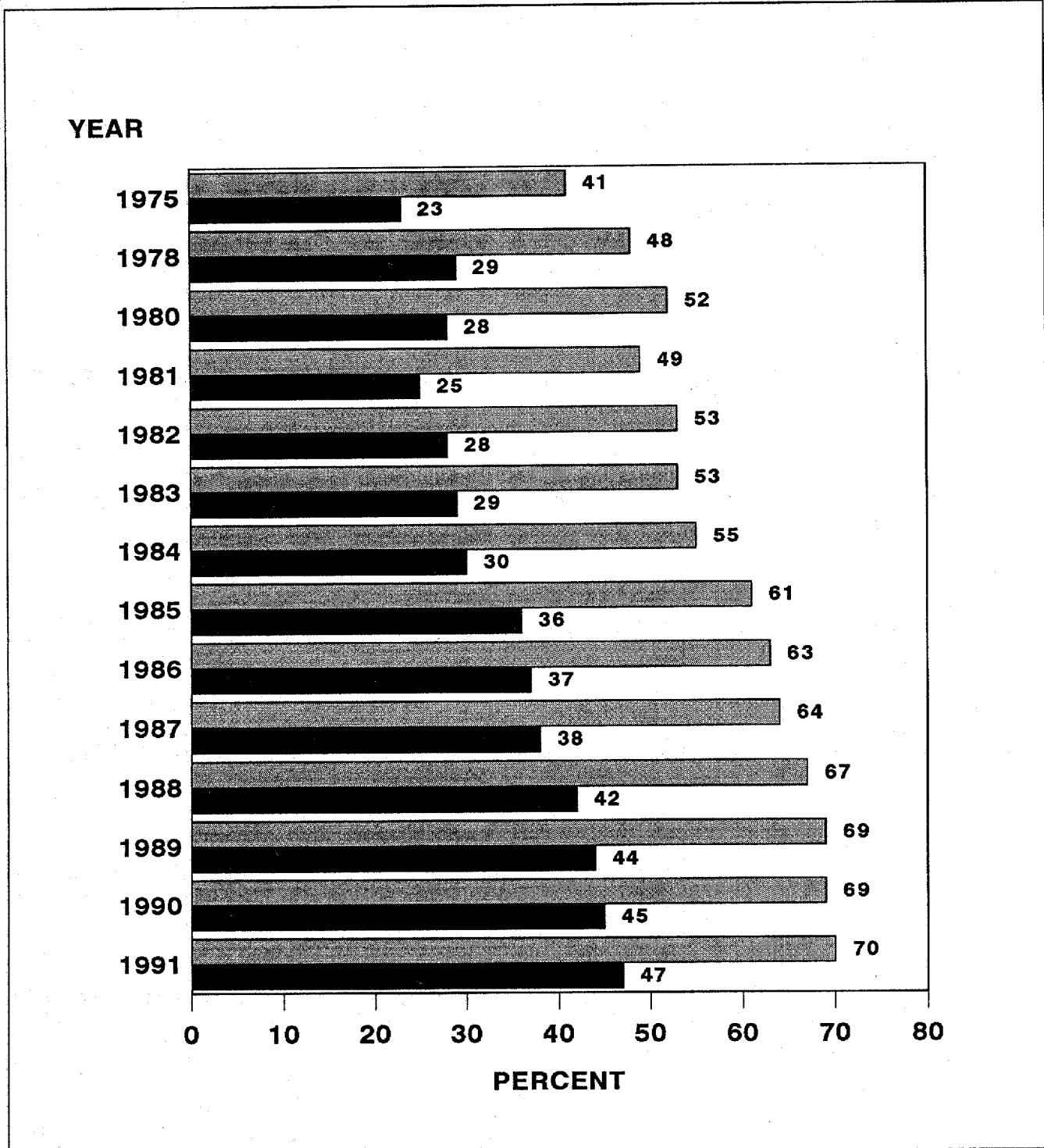

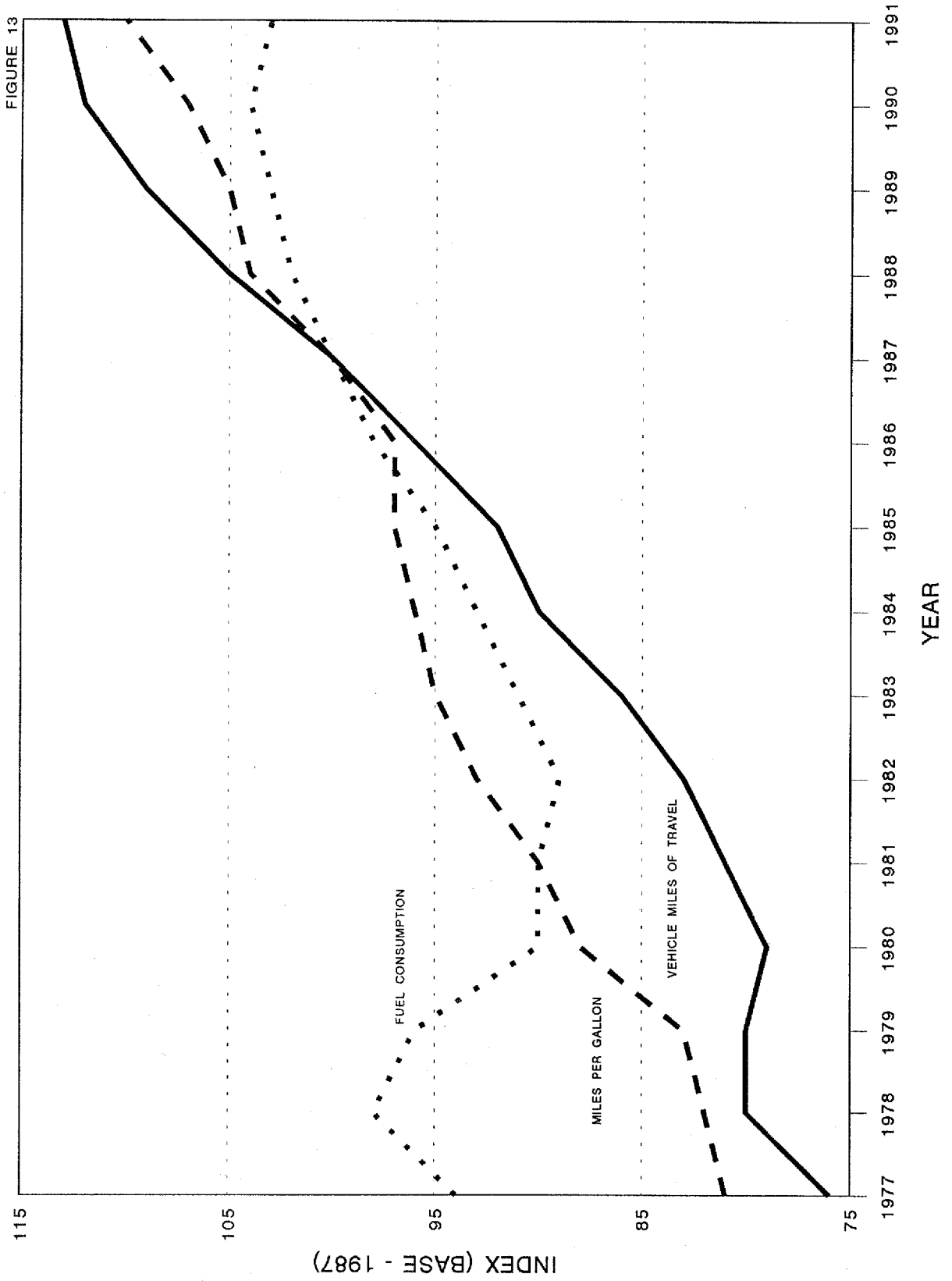

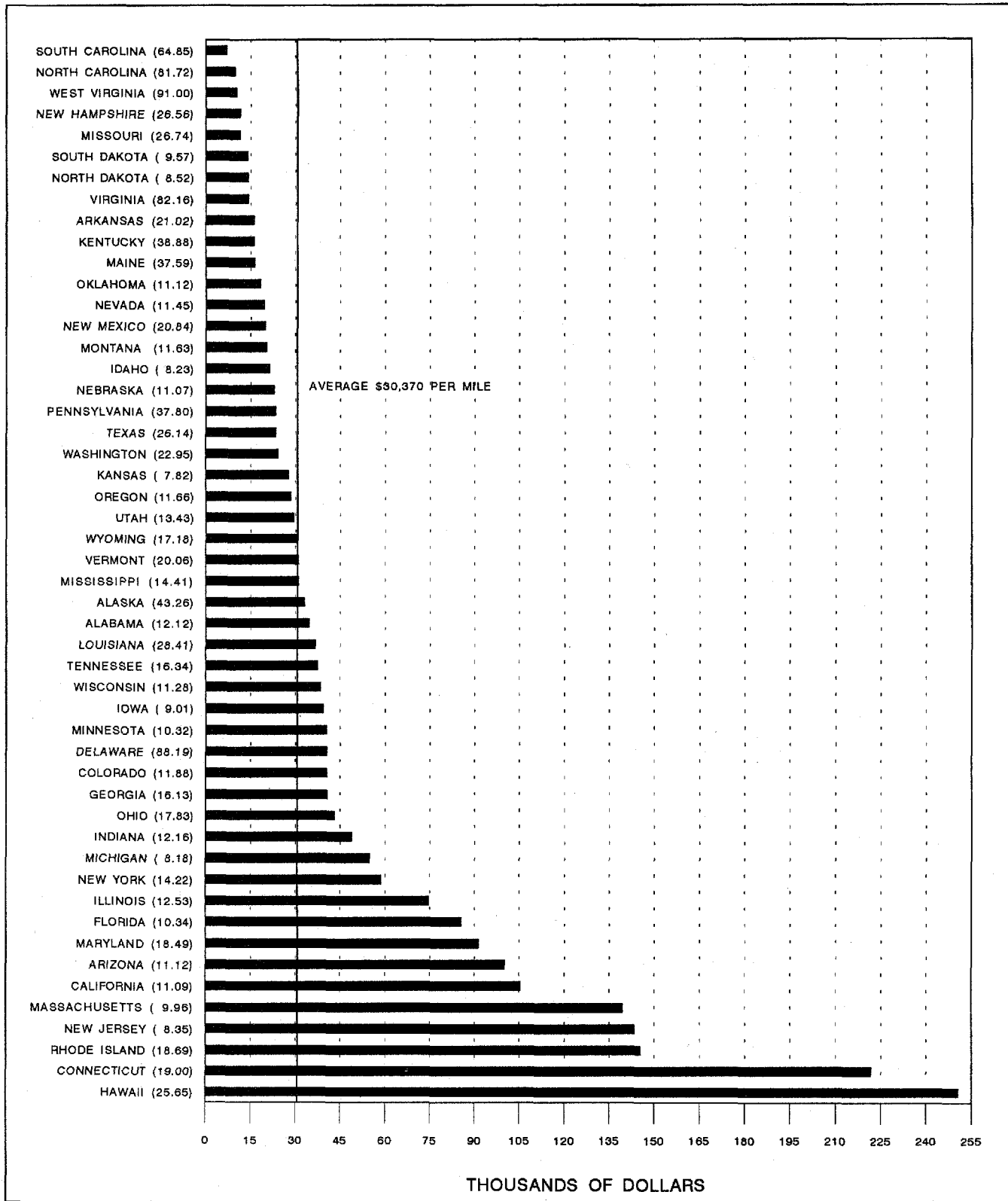

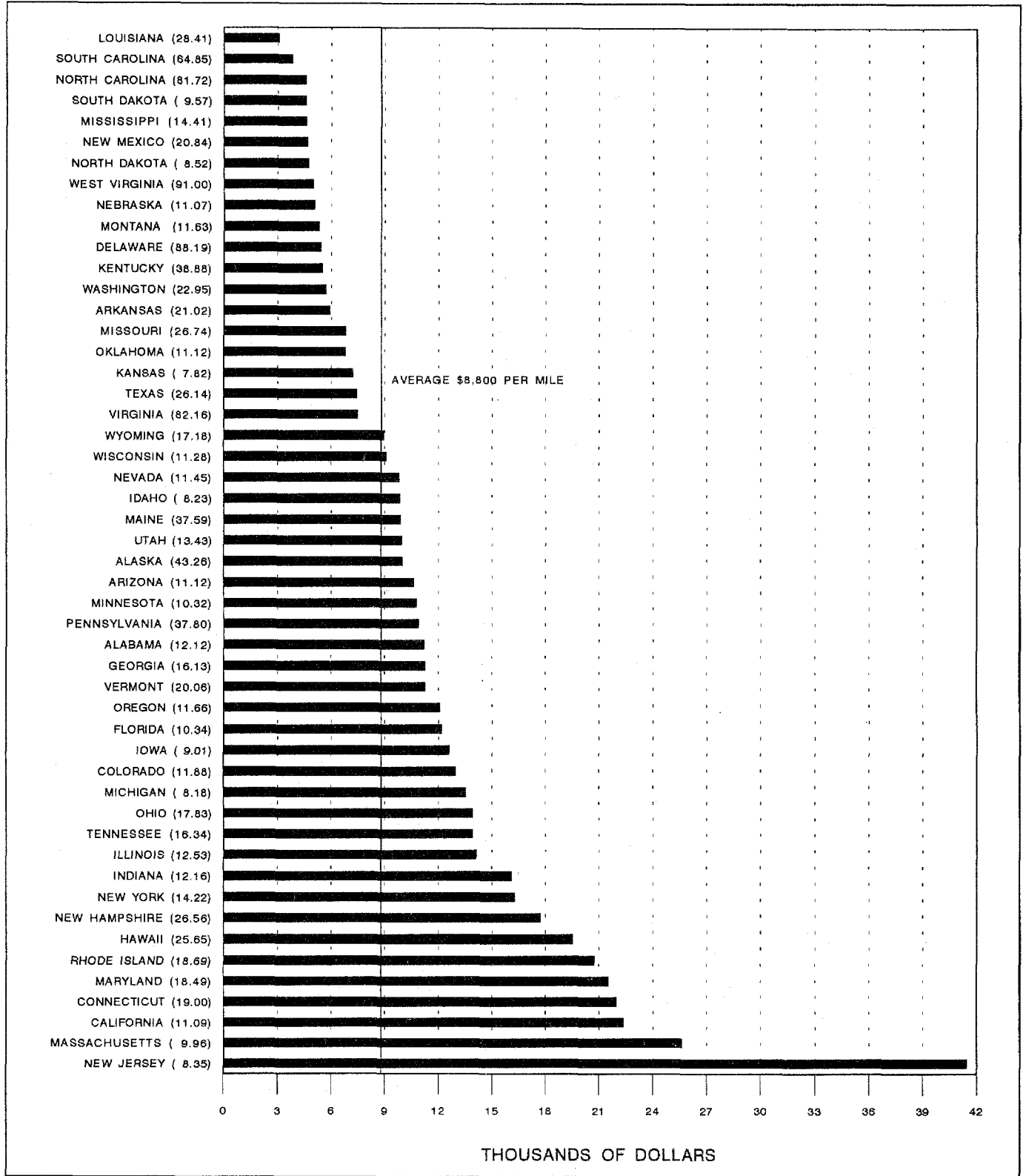

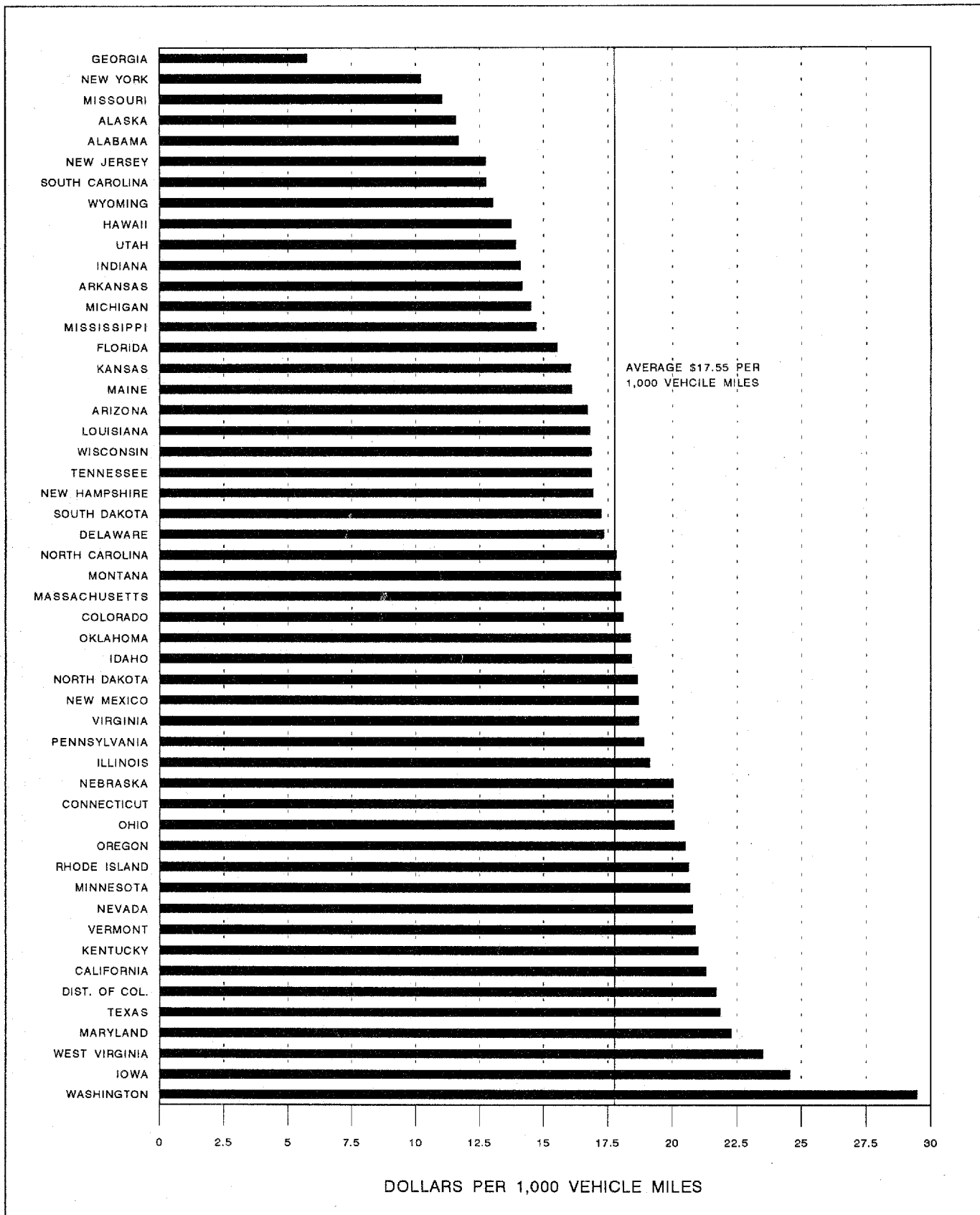

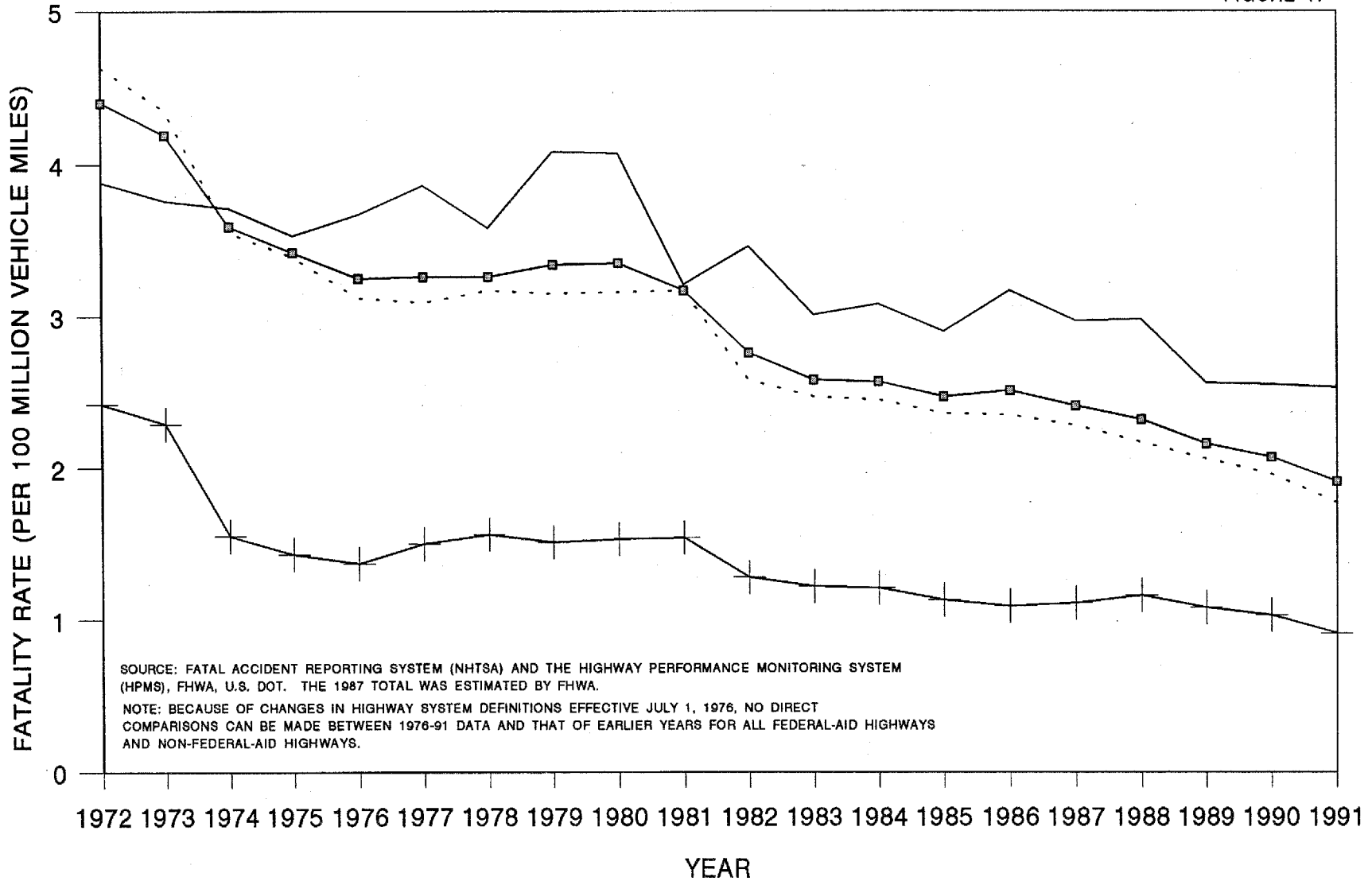
