Use and Documentation of Patient Education codes

Use the Patient Education Protocols when providing education; the education should then be documented using the codes found in this booklet. Correct documentation requires the completion of 8 elements: (*denotes required documentation)

1. Readiness to Learn (a JCAHO Requirement)
2. *Disease state, Illness, or Condition
3. *Education Topic Discussed
4. *Level of Understanding
5. *Time (spent providing the education)
6. *Provider Initials
7. Behavior Goal: Goal Not Set, Goal Set, Goal Met, Goal Not Met
8. Comments

1. **RL-RCPT** (Readiness to Learn—Receptive)
2. **ASM** = Asthma
3. **HM** = Home Management
4. **G** = Good Understanding
5. **10** (Minutes) = Time
6. **XYZ** = Provider Initials
7. **GS:** Pt. to avoid indoor triggers (tobacco smoke)
1. **Comments:** Spouse smokes in home/car
Patient Education String:
ASM-HM-G-10-XYZ-GS: Pt. to avoid indoor triggers (tobacco smoke).

Behavior Goal

Providers should not only educate the patient, providers should also assist the patient to set goals that will help them to become healthier.

Documenting Time

Providers should estimate the amount of Time spent providing the patient education and document that Time using whole numbers.

Clinical Reporting System (CRS)

Patient education is tracked in the Clinical Reporting System by: 1) Disease, 2) Education Topic discussed, 3) Level of Understanding, 4) Provider, 5) Time, and 6) Behavior Goal.

Documenting Patient Education PCC+ (Form)

Documenting Level of Understanding

RECORDING THE PATIENT'S RESPONSE TO EDUCATION

The following "Levels of Understanding" can be used in the RPMS system:

- Good (G):** Verbalizes understanding
Able to return demonstration or teach-back correctly
- Fair (F):** Verbalizes need for more education
Incomplete return demonstration or teach-back indicates partial understanding
- Poor (P)** Does not verbalize understanding
Unable to return demonstration or teach-back
- Refuse (R):** Refuses education
- Group (GP):** Education provided in group. Unable to evaluate individual response

The PCC Coders can only select "Good, Fair, Poor, Group, or Refused" for the level of understanding. Remember, this section is meant for speedy documentation of brief educational encounters. If you want to write a more lengthy narrative, please do so, on a separate PCC form using the codes to simply summarize your note. On inpatient PCCs each entry must be prefaced by a date.

ICD-9 or General Education Codes - Guidelines For Use -

The subtopic can be used in conjunction with any ICD-9 diagnosis to document patient/family education. The general subtopics should not be used with standard patient education codes. Standard codes can be found in the IHS Patient Education Protocols and Codes Manual (PEPC). As with PEPC, covering 50% of the standards under a subtopic justifies use of the education coding system. The list below is NOT exhaustive, nor is it intended to be.

The provider will write out the following: 1) ICD-9 code or diagnosis, 2) education subtopic, 3) level of understanding (G, F, P, R, Gp), 4) Provider Code or Initials, 5) Time spent providing the education, and 6) GS for Goal Set, GNS for Goal Not Set, GM for Goal Met, and GNM for Goal Not Met if the patient set a goal. For example :

(132.9) Pediculosis – TX – F <provider initials> 10min. – GS: Pt. will wash linens

This would show up on the Health Summary under the Patient Education section as:

(132.9) Pediculosis – Treatment – fair understanding, 10 minutes, <Provider Initials>Goal Set: Pt. will wash linens

AP - ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

The patient and/or family will understand the anatomy and physiology as it relates to the disease state or condition.

C - COMPLICATIONS

The patient and/or family will understand the effects and consequences as a result of this disease state/condition, the failure to manage this disease state/condition, or those that are a result of treatment.

DP - DISEASE PROCESS

The patient/family will understand the condition/disease.

EQ - EQUIPMENT

The patient/family will understand and demonstrate (when appropriate) the proper use and care of home medical equipment.

EX - EXERCISE

The patient/family will understand the role of physical activity to the patient's disease state.

FU - FOLLOW UP

The patient/family will understand the importance of follow-up.

HM - HOME MANAGEMENT

The patient/family will understand the home management of the disease process/condition and will make a plan for implementation.

HY - HYGIENE

The patient will recognize good personal hygiene as an aspect of wellness.

L - LITERATURE

The patient/family will receive literature about the disease process literature about the disease process or condition.

LA - LIFESTYLE ADAPTATIONS

The patient will understand the lifestyle adaptations necessary to prevent complications of the disease state/condition or to improve mental or physical health.

M - MEDICATIONS

The patient/family will understand the purpose, proper use, and expected outcomes of their drug therapy.

MNT- MEDICAL NUTRITION THERAPY

For use by registered dietitians ONLY

The patient/family will understand the specific nutritional interventions needed in the disease state/condition.

N - NUTRITION

The patient will understand the need for balanced nutrition and will plan for the implementation of dietary modification if needed.

P - PREVENTION

The patient/family will understand that healthy lifestyle behaviors can reduce the risk of developing diseases, conditions, or complications.

PRO - PROCEDURES

The patient/family will understand the proposed procedure, including the indications, complications, and alternatives, as well as, possible results of non-treatment.

S - SAFETY

The patient/family will understand the principles of injury prevention and will plan a safe environment.

TE - TESTS

The patient/family will understand the tests to be performed, including indications and their impact on further care.

TX - TREATMENT

The patient/family will understand the mutually agreed upon treatment plan.

IMPORTANT CHANGES IN THE 14TH EDITION

CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY CHANGE: Reminder: The mnemonic CD for Chemical Dependency has been changed to AOD - Alcohol and Other Drugs. Questions/concerns about this change should be addressed to Gabriel.longhi@ihs.gov, OIT BH representative.

CULTURAL/SPIRITUAL ASPECTS OF HEALTH (CUL): CUL is to be used to document education/counseling that reflects an integration of the impact and influences that cultural and spiritual traditions, practices, and beliefs have on health and wellness.

MEDICAL NUTRITION THERAPY (MNT): Only Registered Dietitians are permitted to use the MNT code. Questions concerning the MNT protocols and codes should be directed to Cecelia.butler@ihs.gov

WELLNESS CHANGED TO HPDP: The mnemonic WL has been changed to HPDP - Health Promotion, Disease Prevention. Questions concerning HPDP protocols and codes should be directed to Freda.carpitcher@ihs.gov.

GRIEF: In addition to Grief with losses other than “end of life” GRIEF was added to address the education provided to patients who are grieving because of other losses. These losses may include a home, a spouse through divorce, a job, or even a favorite pet. The standards are general so they can be adapted to a wide variety of situations.

LITERATURE (L) :The title for literature given to the patient was previously Patient Education Literature. It has been changed to Literature.

CASE MANAGEMENT (CM): The title previously associated with the mnemonic CM was *Care* Management has been changed throughout the Manual to **Case** Management.

RHEUMATIC DISEASE CHANGED TO RHEUMATIC ARTHRITIS: The PEP-C previously contained a topic and mnemonic called Rheumatic Disease (RD). This will be inactivated and the new topic/mnemonic is RA – Rheumatic Arthritis. We have plans to develop protocols for Osteoarthritis and Juvenile Rheumatoid Arthritis. Most other “Rheumatic Diseases” can be covered with the mnemonic ATO- Autoimmune Disorders.

HEART FAILURE CHANGE: The PEP-C previously contained a topic and mnemonic called Congestive Health Failure (CHF). This will be inactivated and the topic/mnemonic is HF—Heart Failure. A Discharge A Discharge Literature code (HF-DCHL) was added to address the CMS requirement of discharge literature.

SUICIDAL BEHAVIOR (SB) CHANGE: was changed to SI - Suicidal Ideation/Gestures

CELIAC DISEASE: Celiac Disease (CEL) is a new code.

DEPRESSION (DEP): changed from Depression, Major to Depressive disorder

Domestic Violence: “General” education on Domestic Violence (DV) remains; but has also been expanded to include Domestic Violence Victim—(DVV) and Domestic Violence Perpetrator (DVP).
