

Return to a predisturbed condition as reasonably practical

Plans for Surface Reclamation

- Item J of the 12-point SUPO
 - Segregation of spoil materials
 - Redistribution of topsoil
 - Configuration of reshaped topography
 - Backfill requirements
 - Surface disturbances
 - Proposals for pit/sump closures
 - Drainage systems
 - Soil treatments

Plans for Surface Reclamation

- Item J of the 12-point SUPO (cont.)
 - Seeding/steps to reestablish vegetation
 - Weed control; and
 - Practices necessary to reclaim all disturbed areas, including any access roads and pipelines.

Reclamation

Interim and Final Reclamation


- 6 months after well completion or well plugging
 - BLM or FS approval required beyond 6 months
- Prior approval required if pits will be air or chemical dried
