As an electrical power systems engineer I am actively involved with lighting and energy conservation. I recently reviewed the Proposed Category "A" Additions to the Program Requirements for Solid State Lighting Luminaires. I strongly support Energy Star adopting the document. The Zonal Lumen Density Requirements that all light be below 90 degrees on most of the fixtures (except bollards) are especially encouraging. The below-90-degree requirement supports efficiency by only directing light where it is needed and will reduce the safety hazards of glare.
