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# Introduction

The California Area 2005 Summary Report contains information about selected clinical GPRA measures collected from 23 tribal and 3 urban programs using CRS 5.1 software. This report is a companion to the 2005 Executive Summary and the 2005 12-Area Report. Taken together, these three reports allow individual health programs to see how their performance contributes to California Area and national GPRA performance and how California Area performance compares with other Areas. The California Area Report and the 12-Area Report contain detailed, comparative performance information for programs and Areas. The Executive Summary includes contextual information about GPRA measures and also contains a reference section for those who would like to review the clinical literature relating to measures.

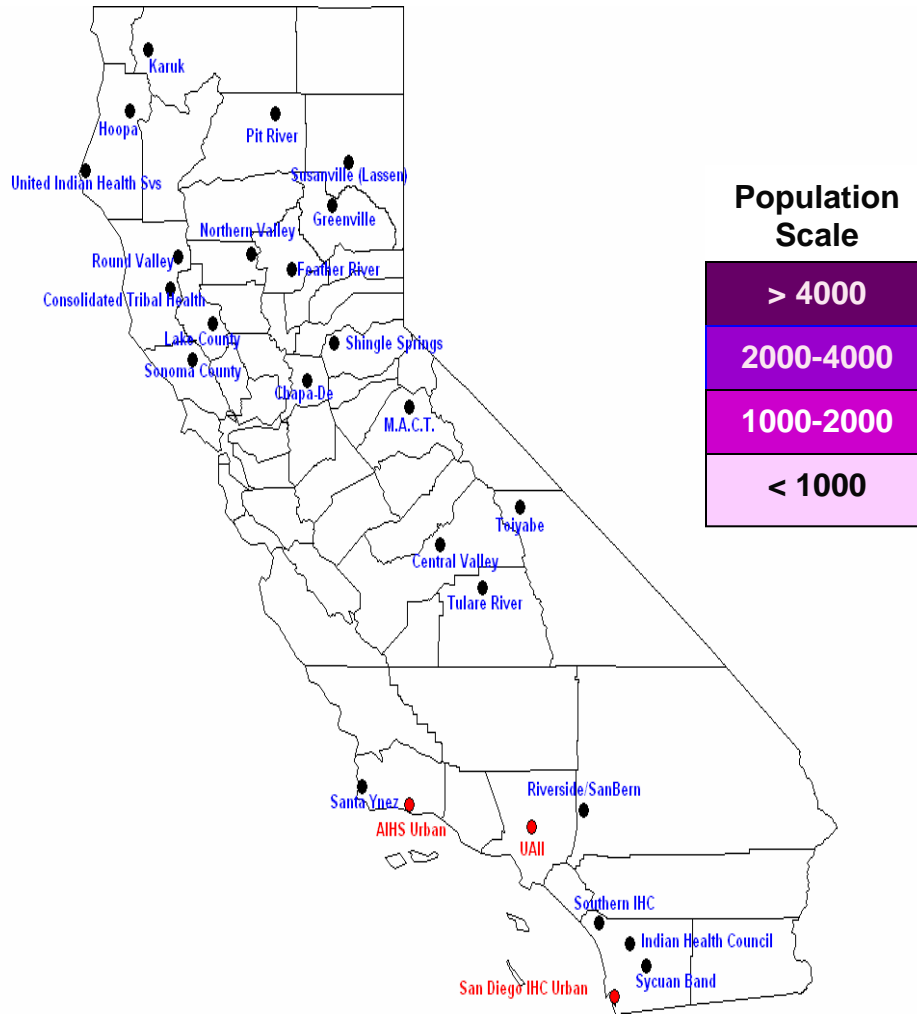
The California Area Summary Report includes graphs for each clinical GPRA measure. These graphs display results by health program for GPRA year (GY) 2005 and GY 2004. The 2005 GPRA year ran from July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. In addition, each graph includes the California Area Average for GY 2005 and Healthy People 2010 or IHS 2010 goals. The last row under each graph shows the number of patient records examined to calculate the rate for the measure. These graphs will allow each health program to review the change in their own performance from GY 2004 to GY 2005, compare their performance with other California programs and with Area and national Averages, and assess their progress toward achieving long-term national goals. On the following page, a table lists GPRA population numbers, so programs can benchmark their progress against programs of similar size.

The long-term objective of this report is to provide California Area Indian Health Programs with comparable and consistent performance data. The ability to access performance data at the local level will allow health programs to identify where they need to make improvements in their delivery of clinical services. This data will also allow the California Area to consider using performance as a factor in the distribution of new funds.

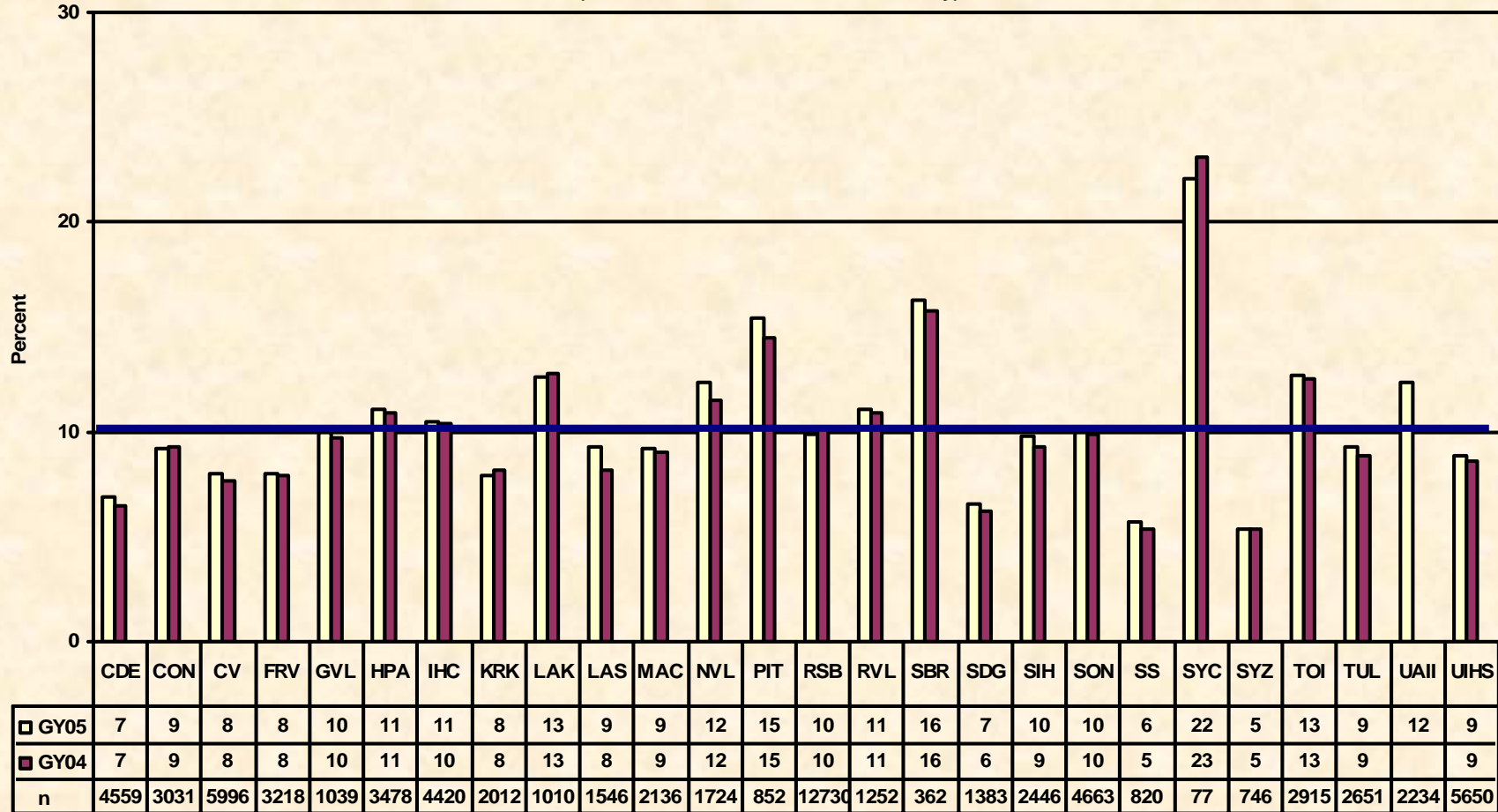

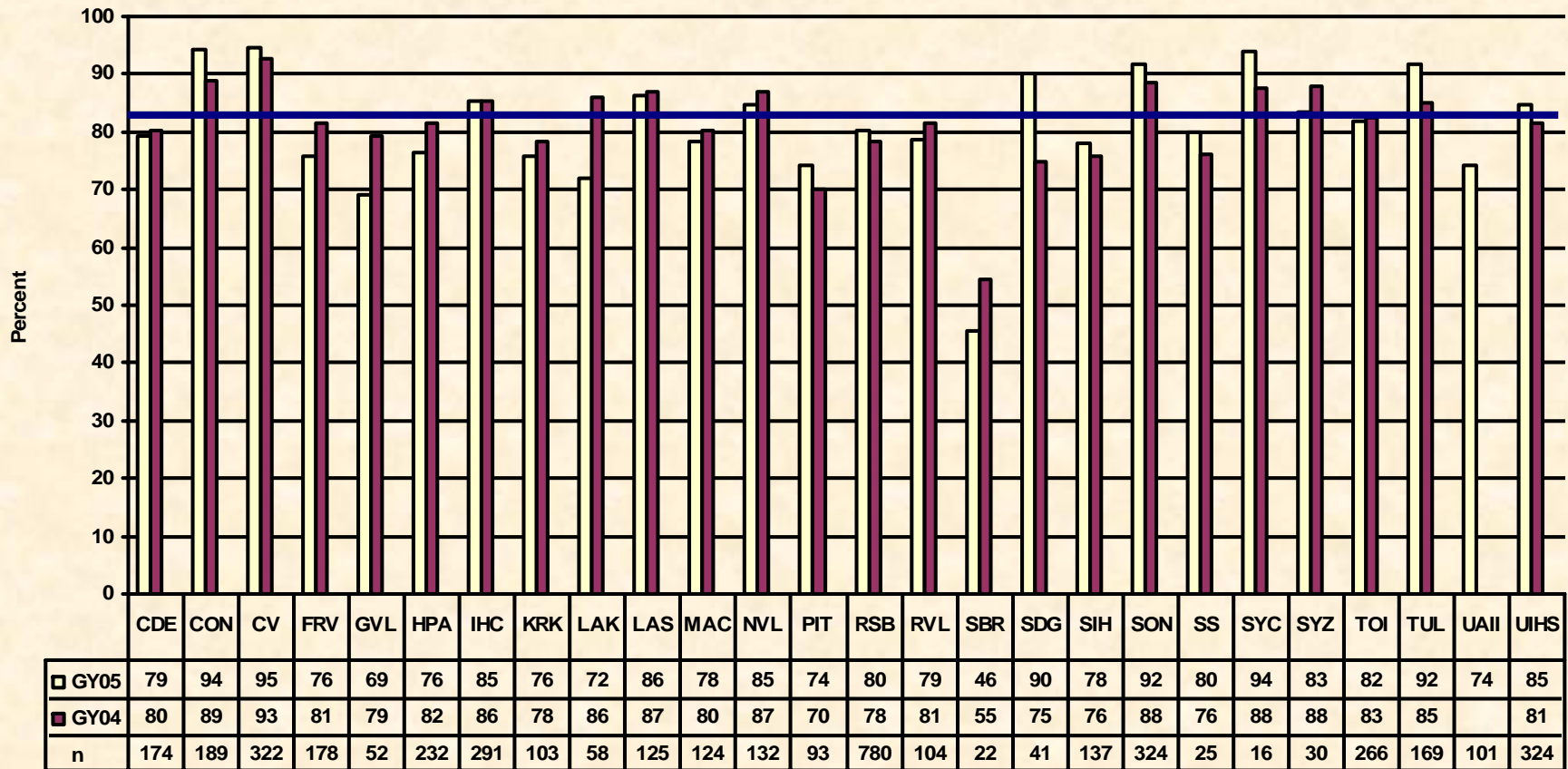
**California Area Comparison - GPRA 2005**

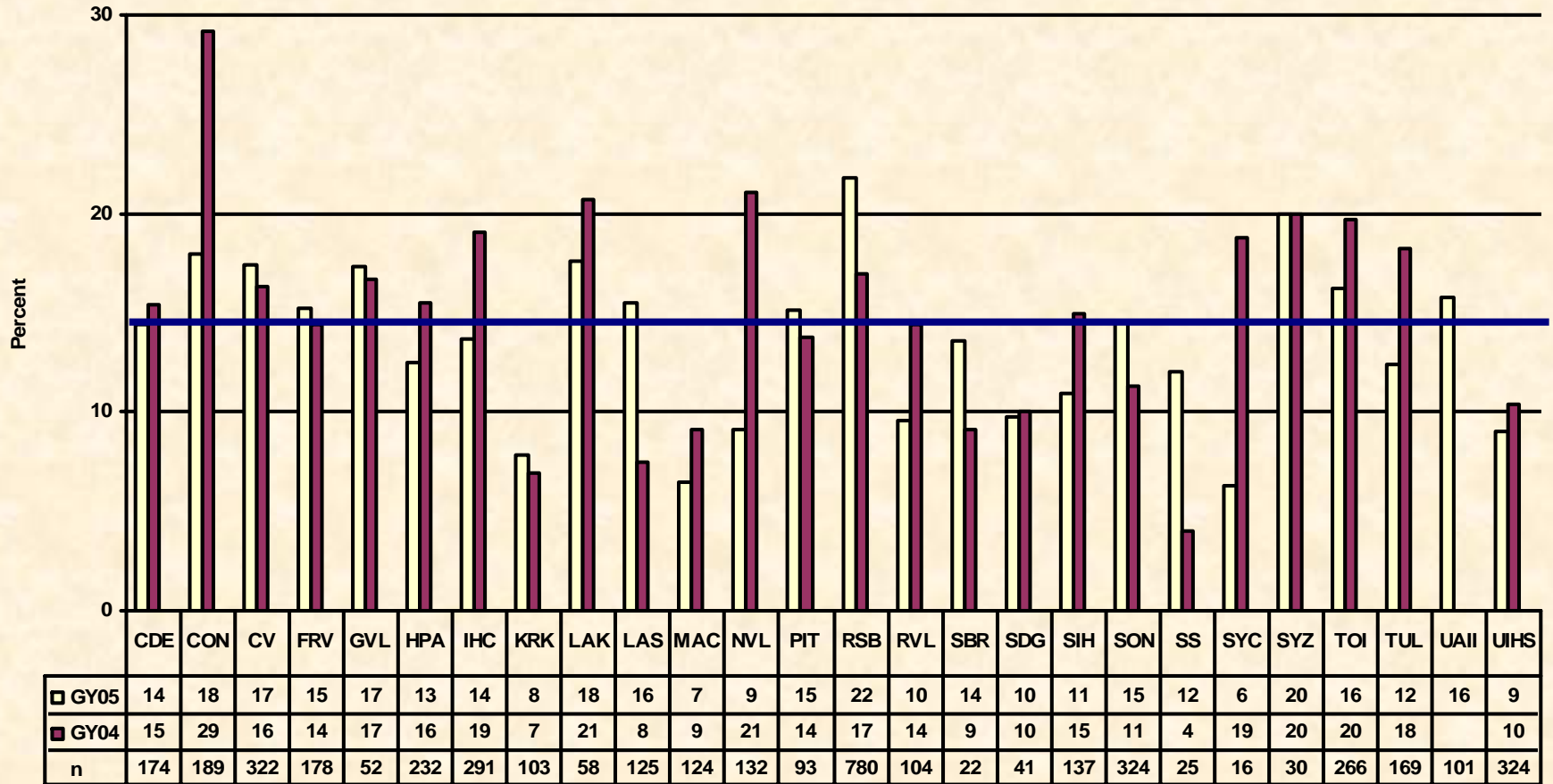

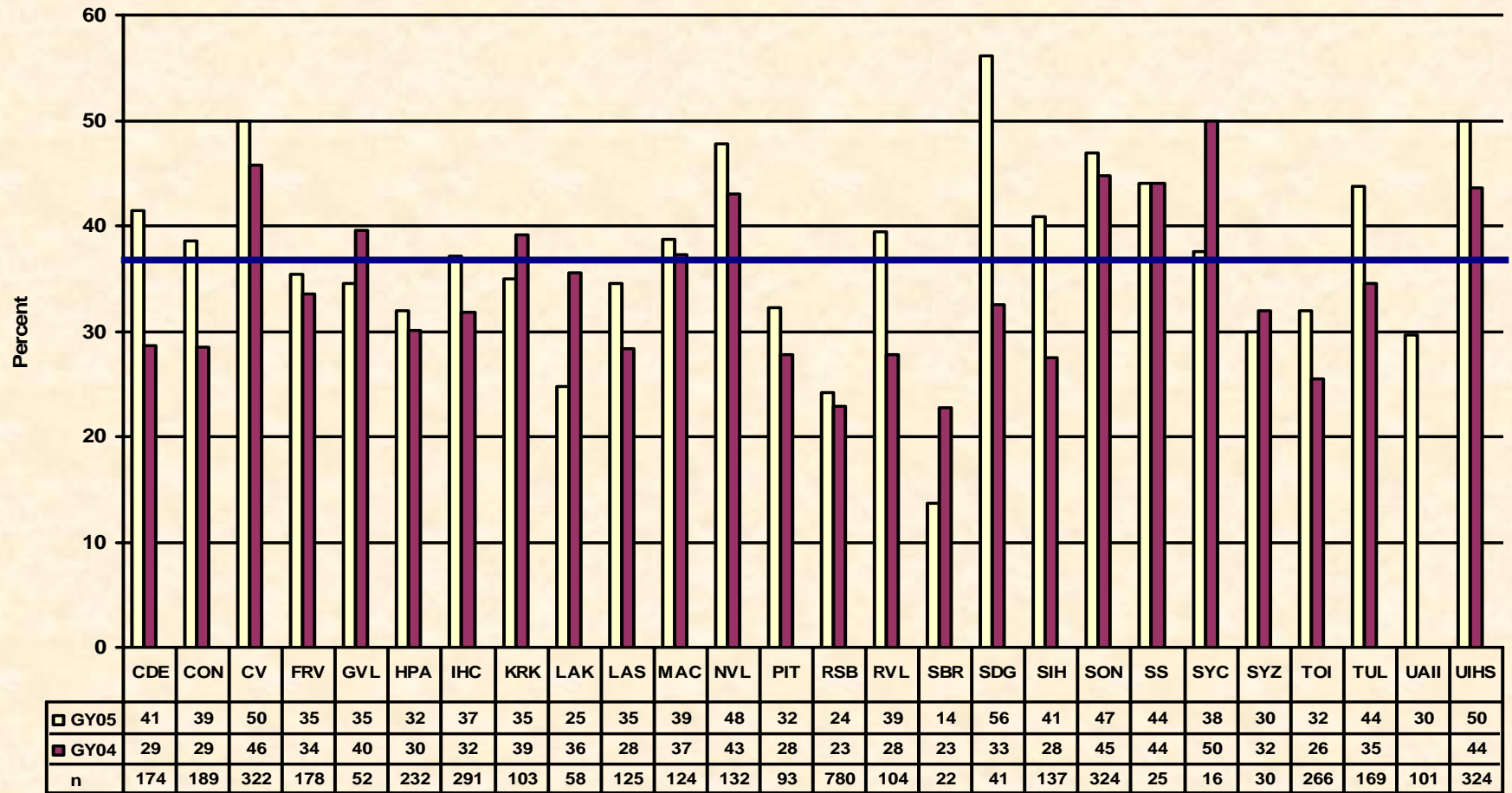
**California Area Comparison - GPR 2005**

 Ideal Glycemic Control

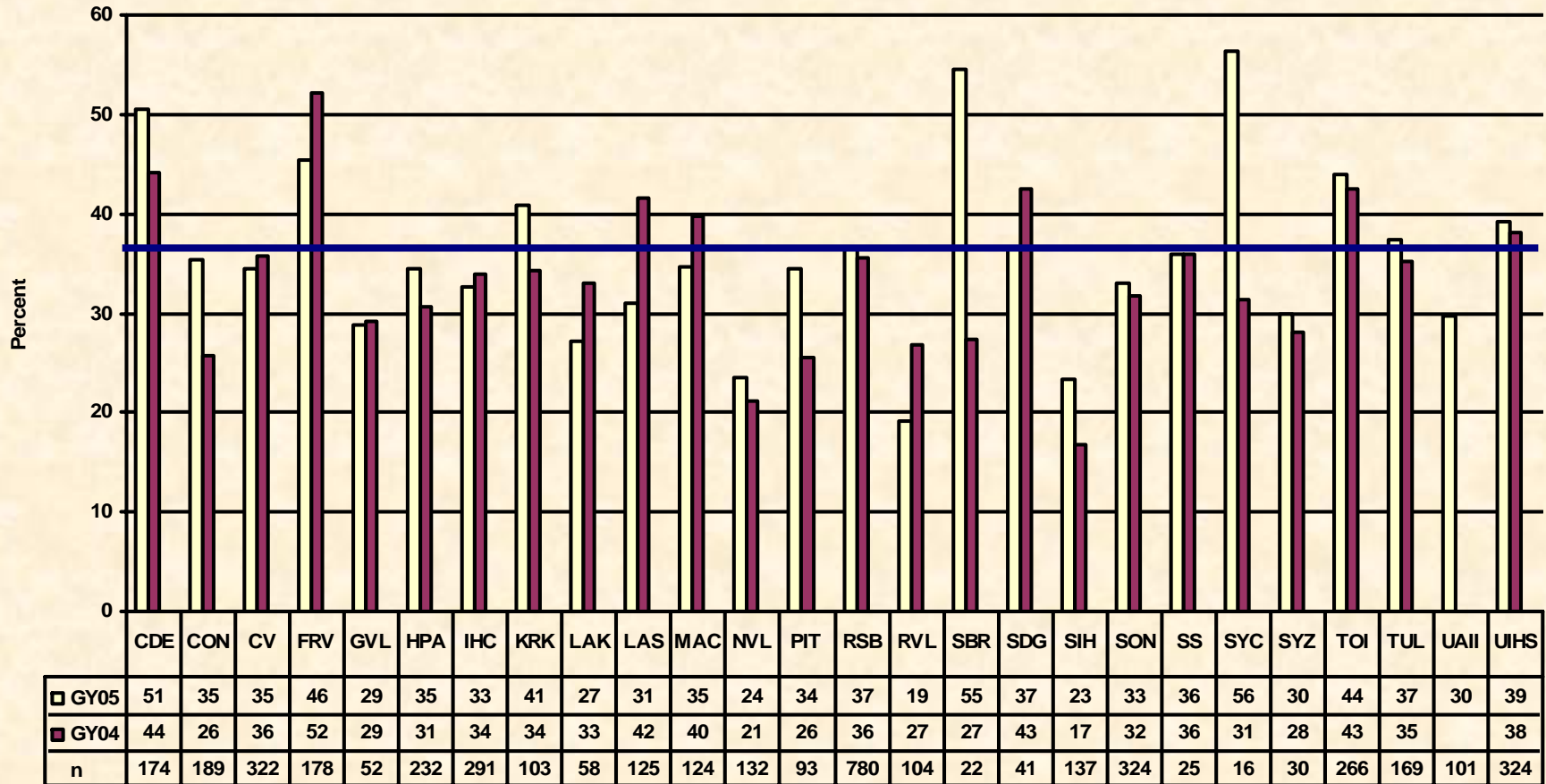

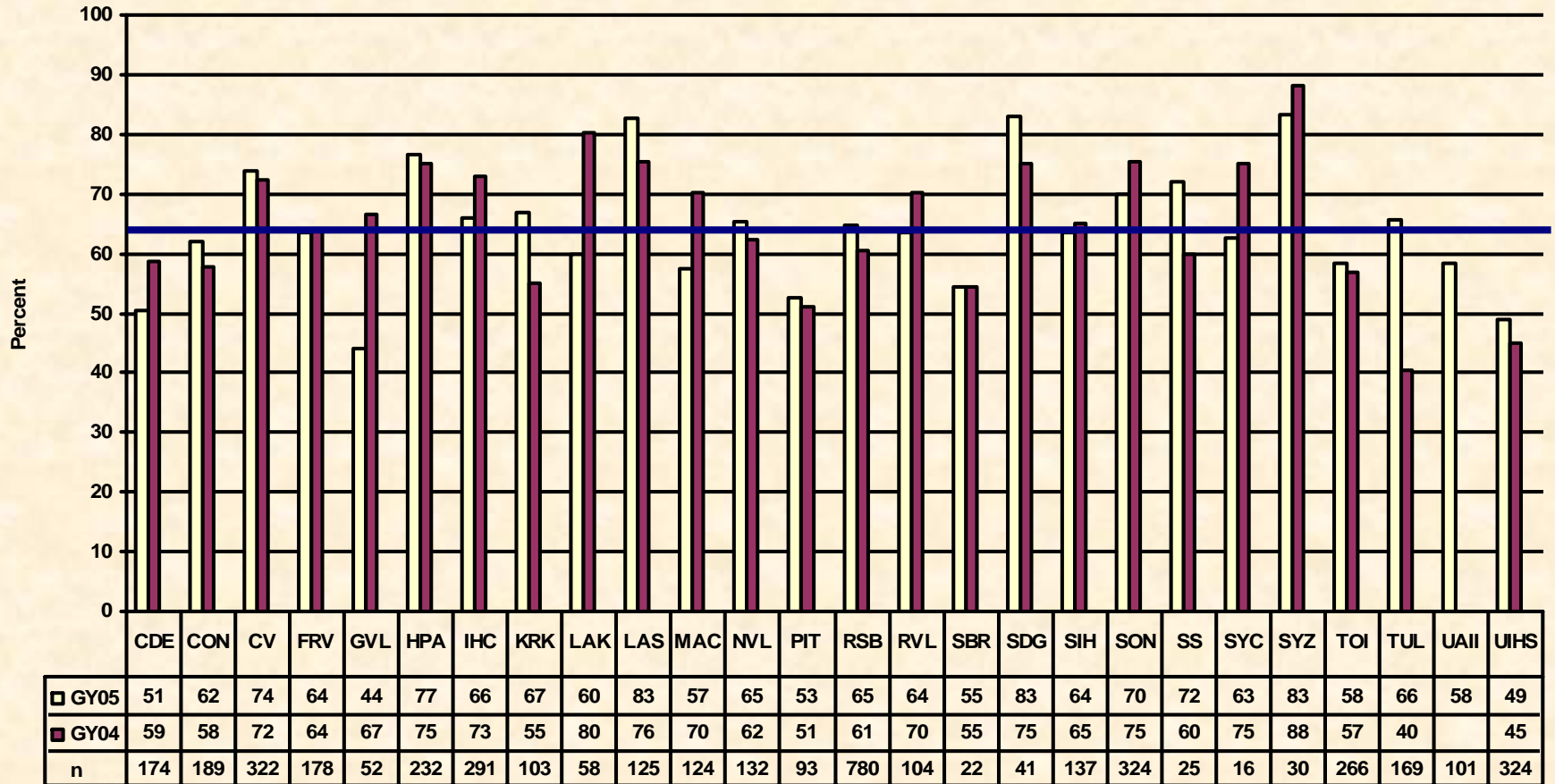

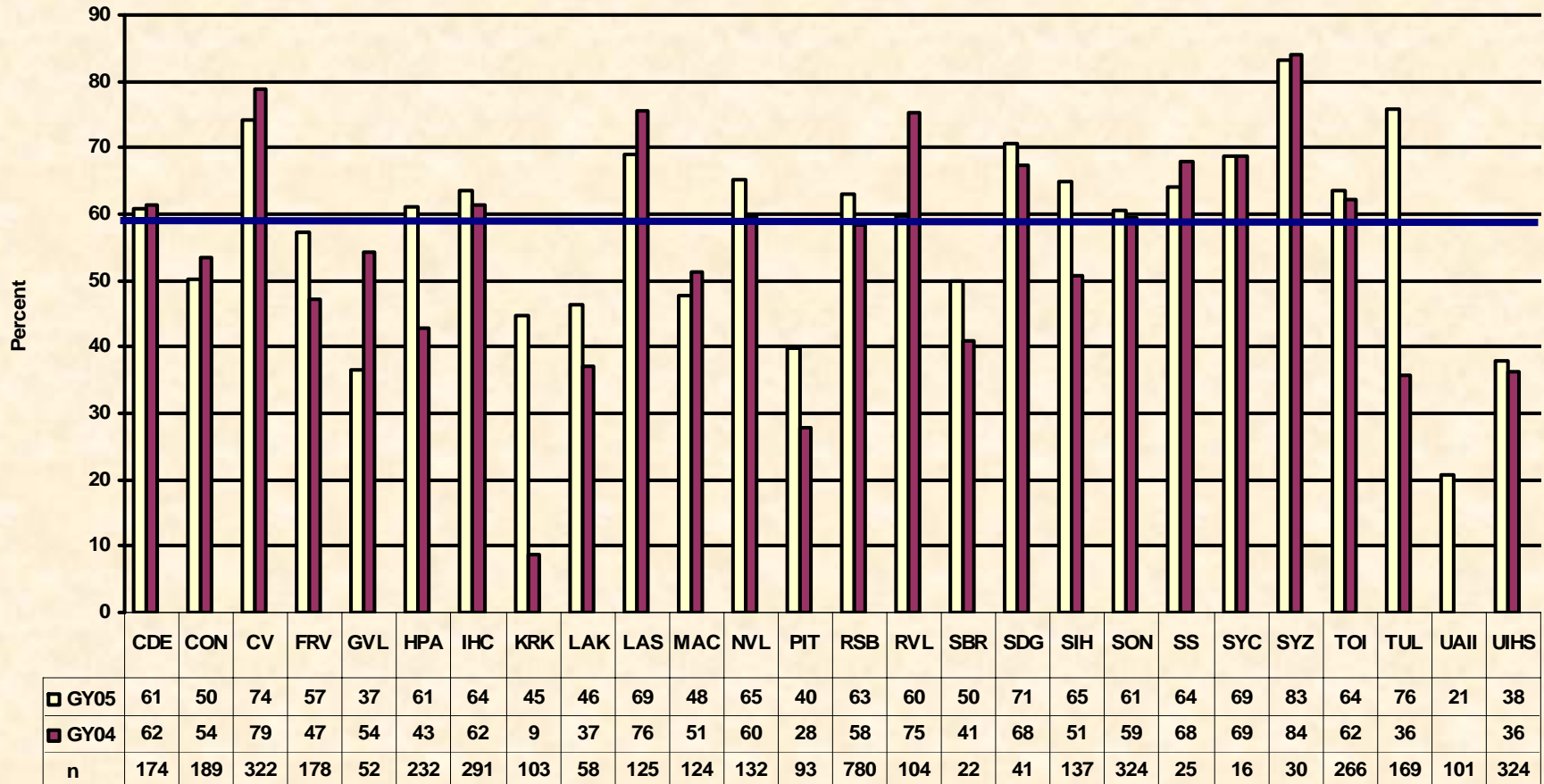
California Area Comparison - GPRA 2005

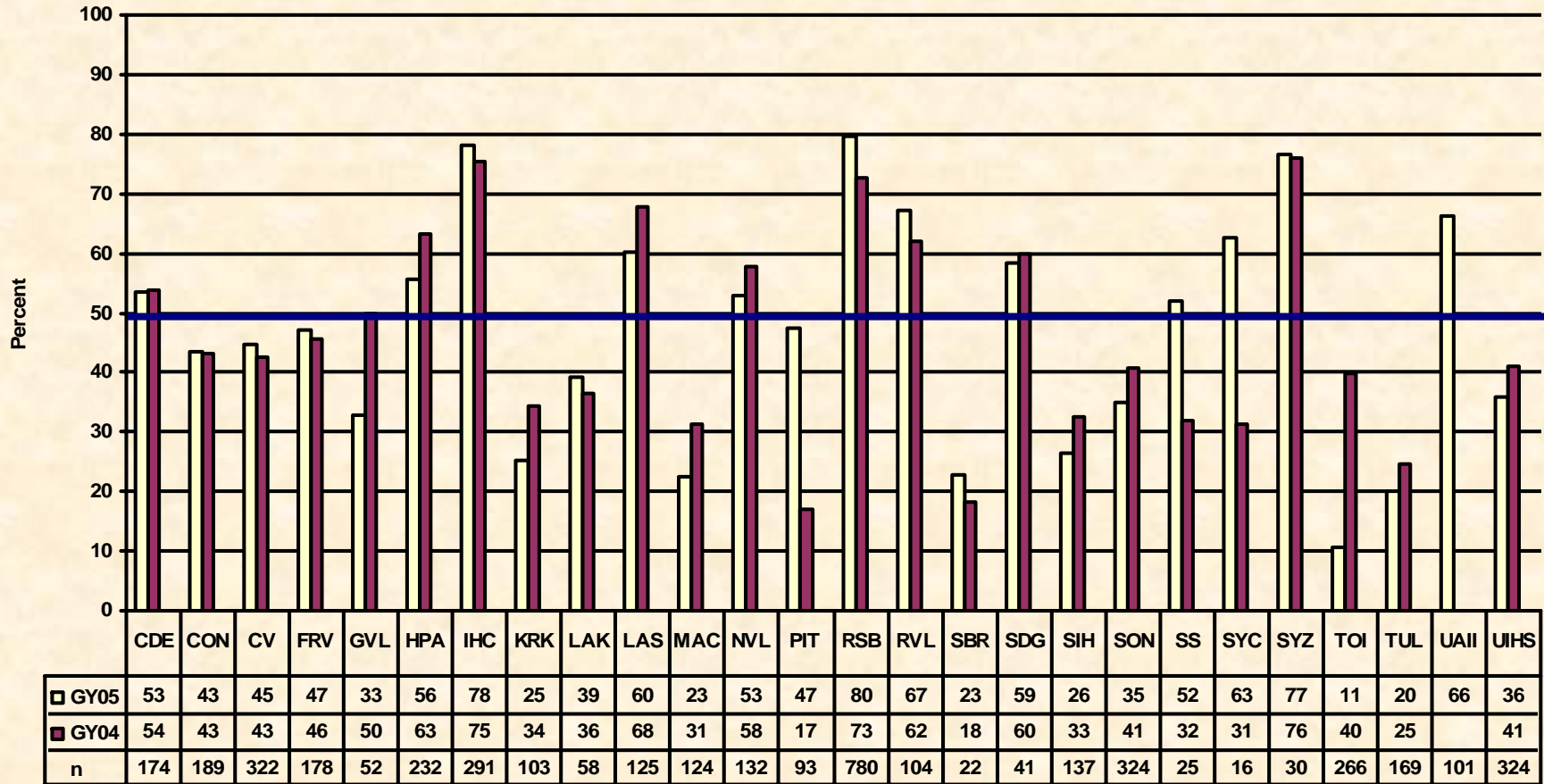
California Area Comparison - GPR 2005

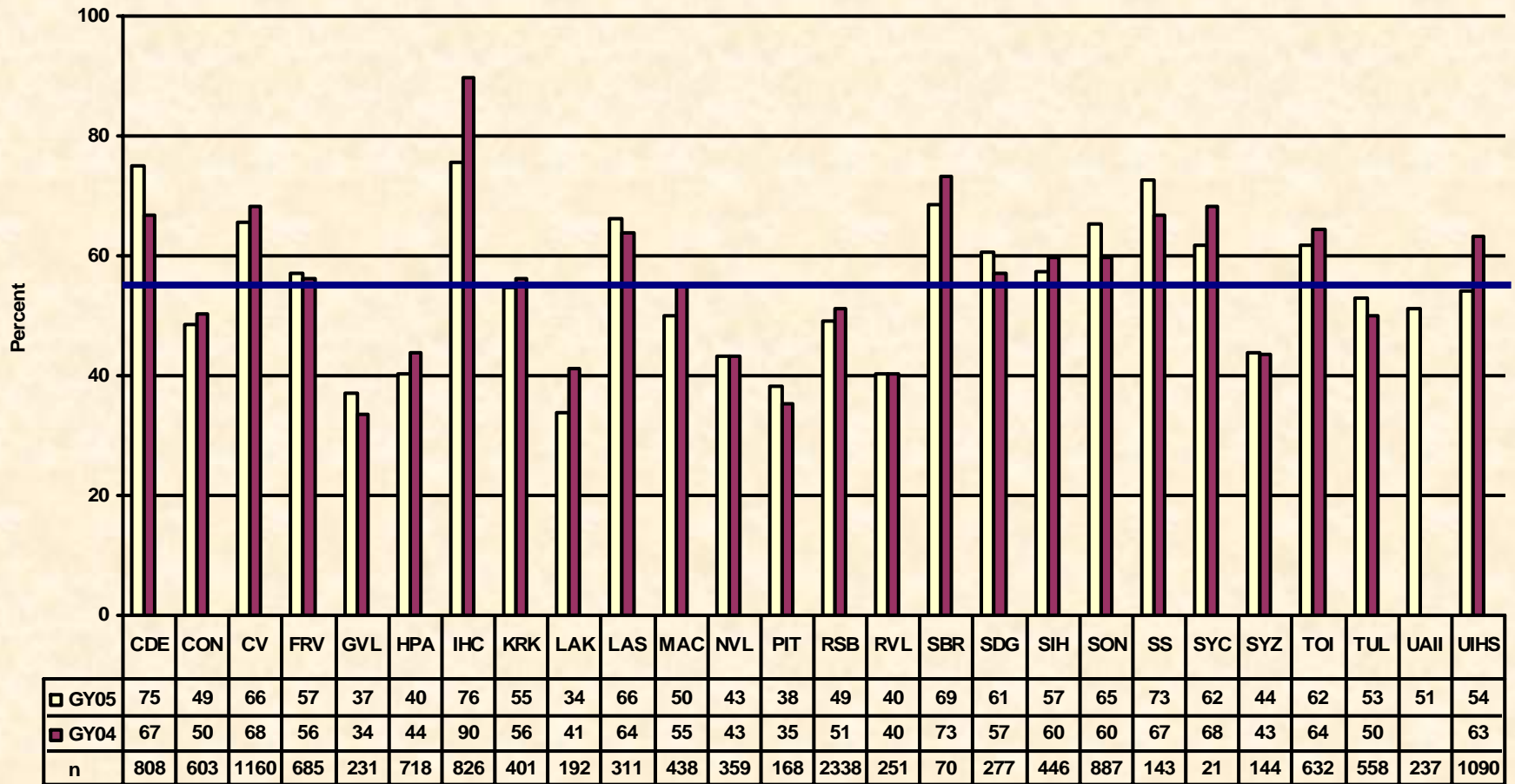

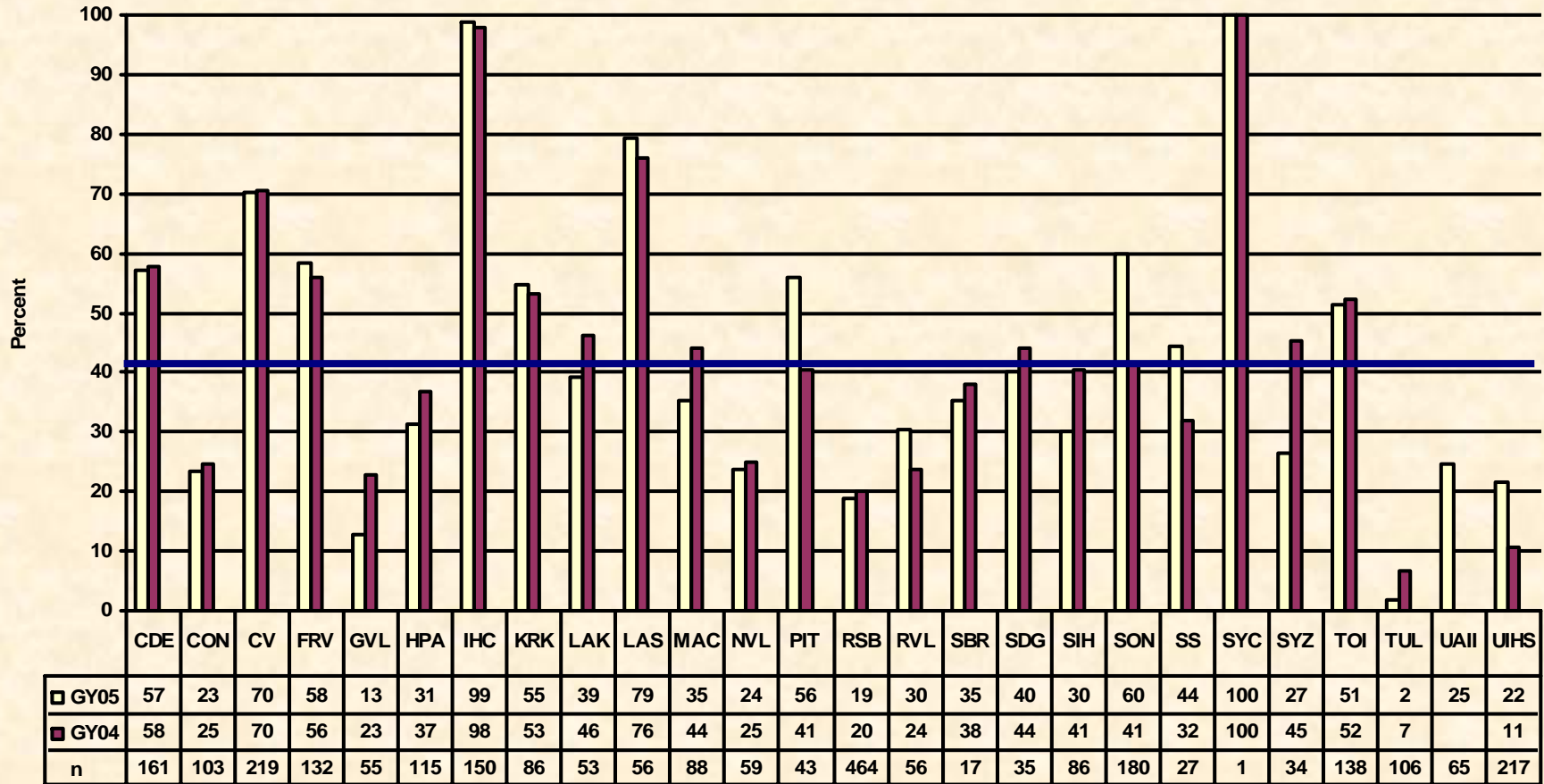

 Mammography Screening

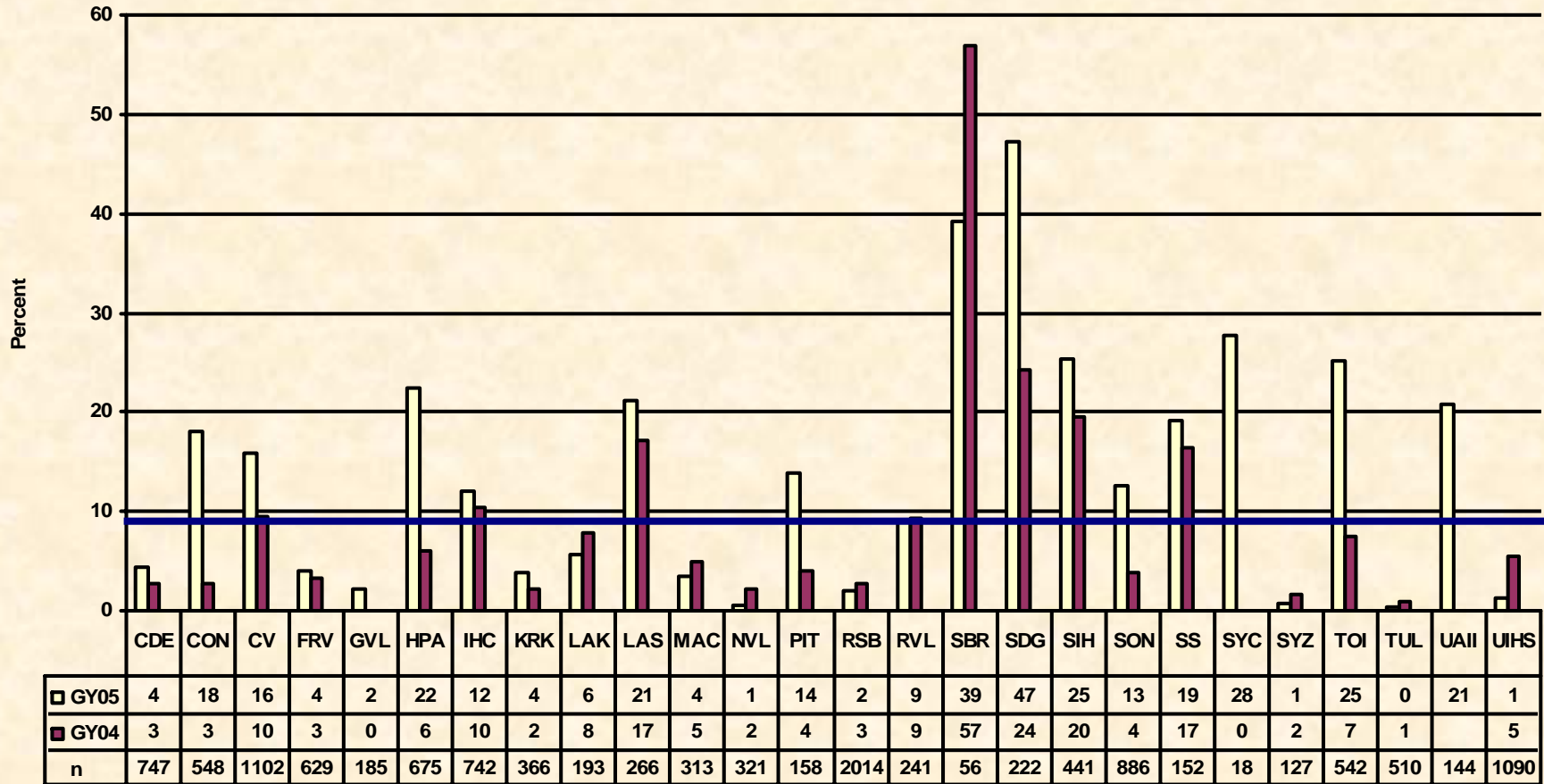

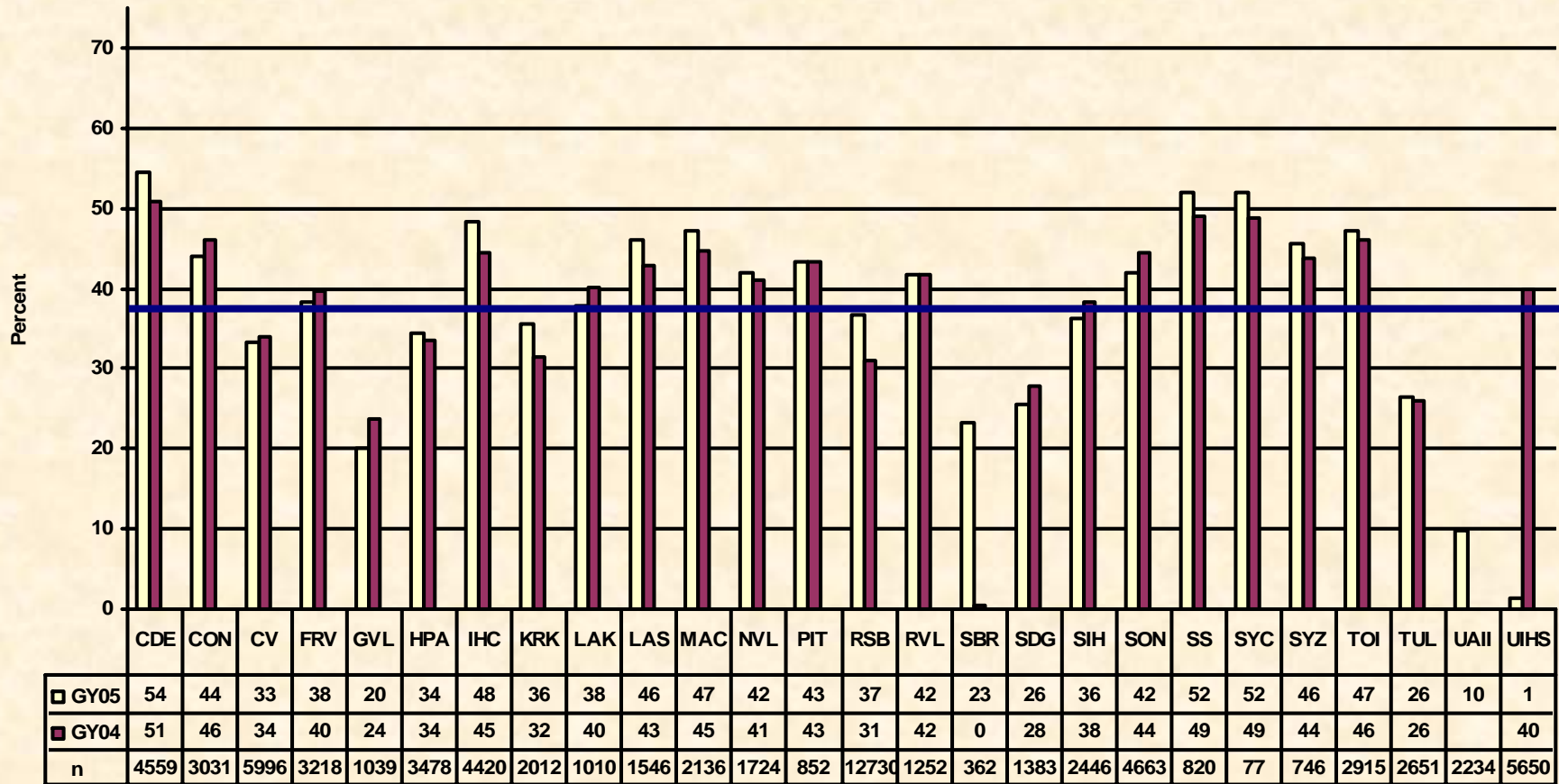

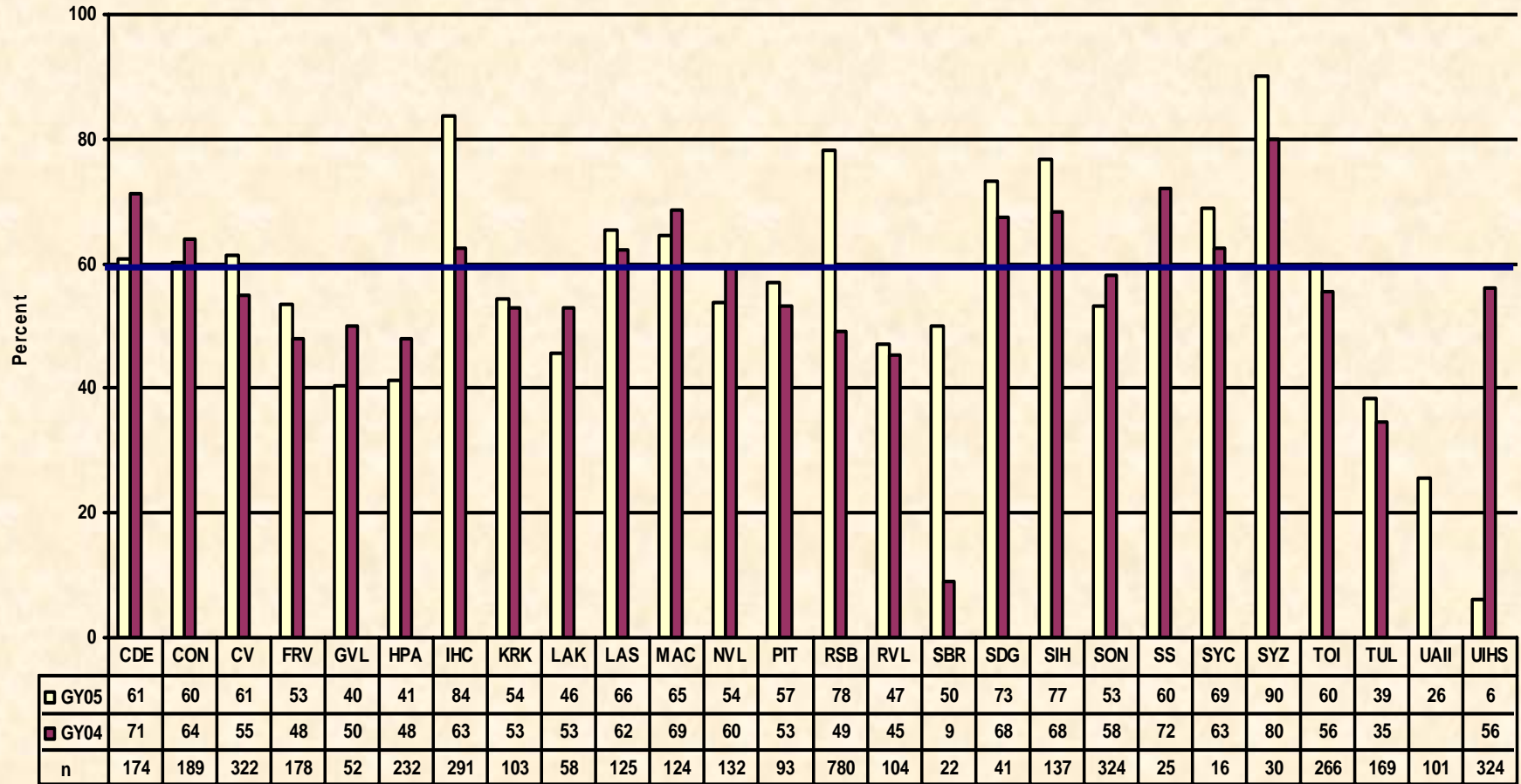

### Diabetes: Dental Access\*

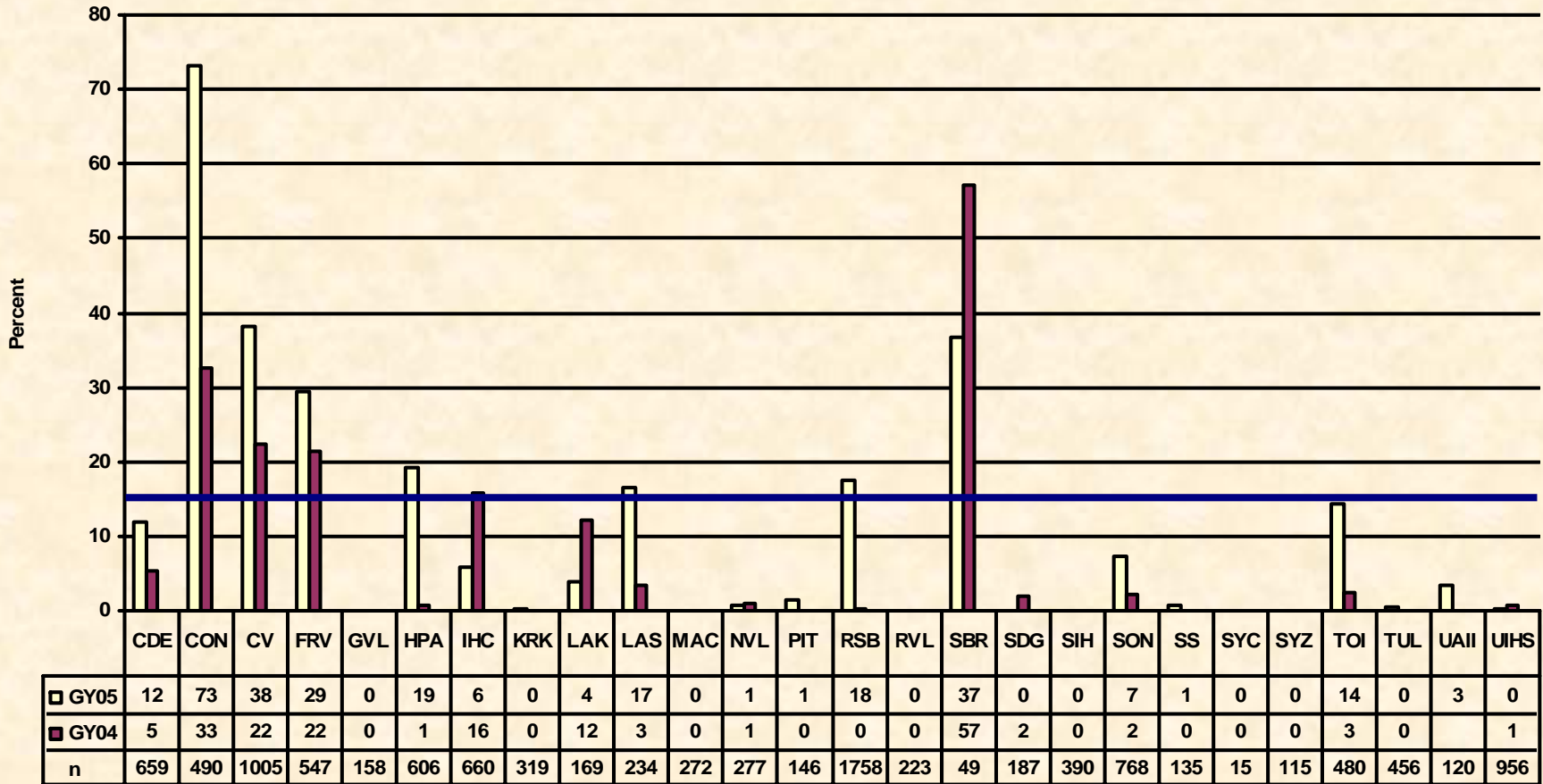

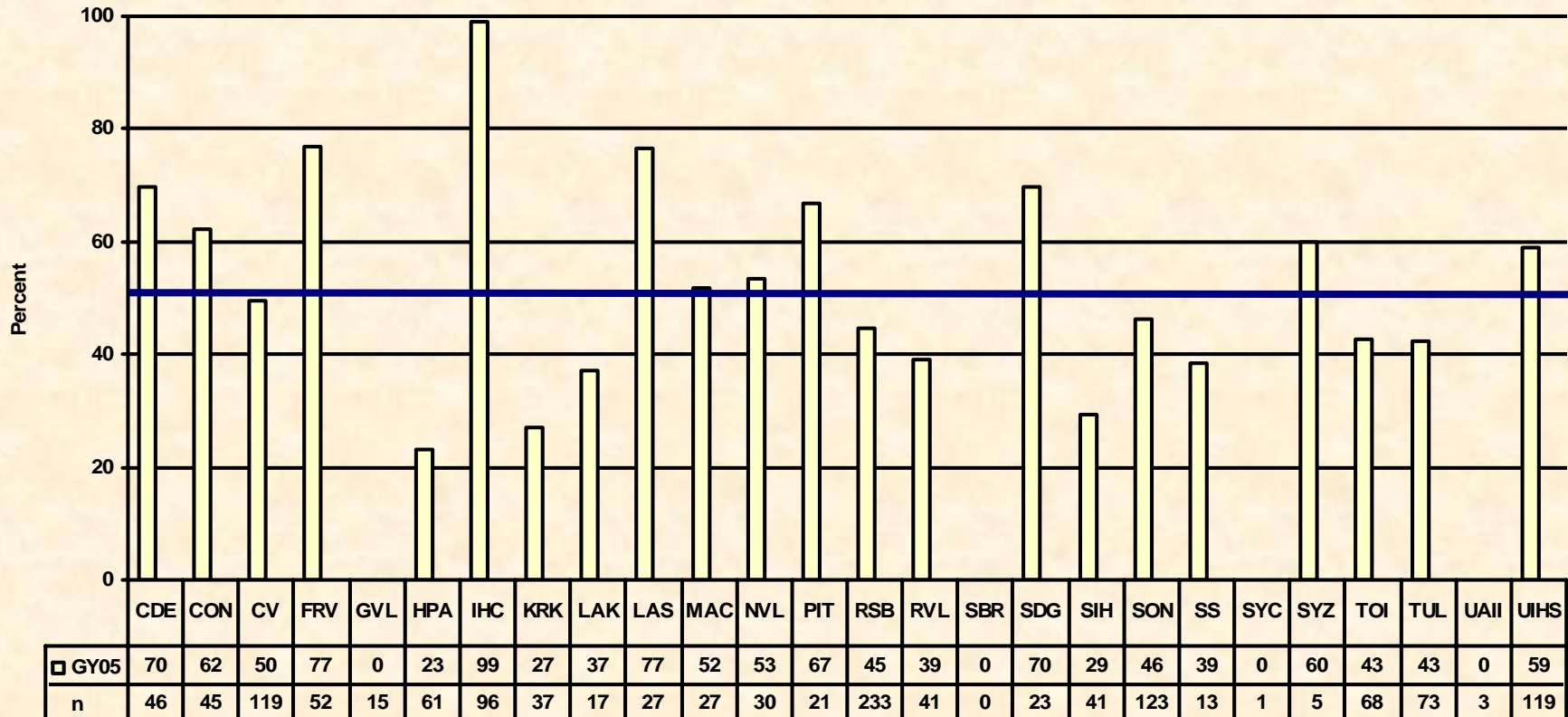

## California Area Comparison - GPRA 2005 Childhood Immunizations\*

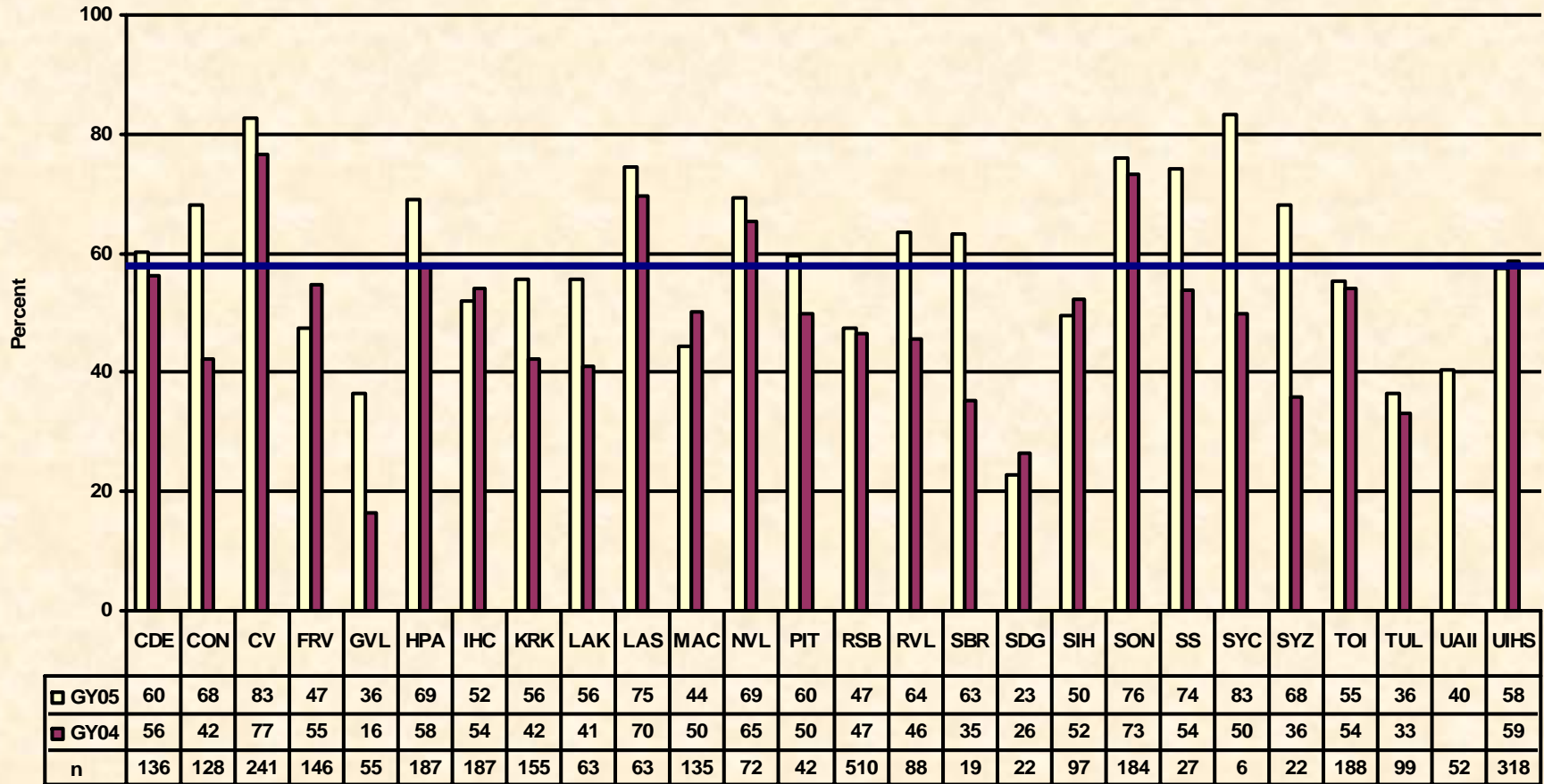

 Influenza Immunization

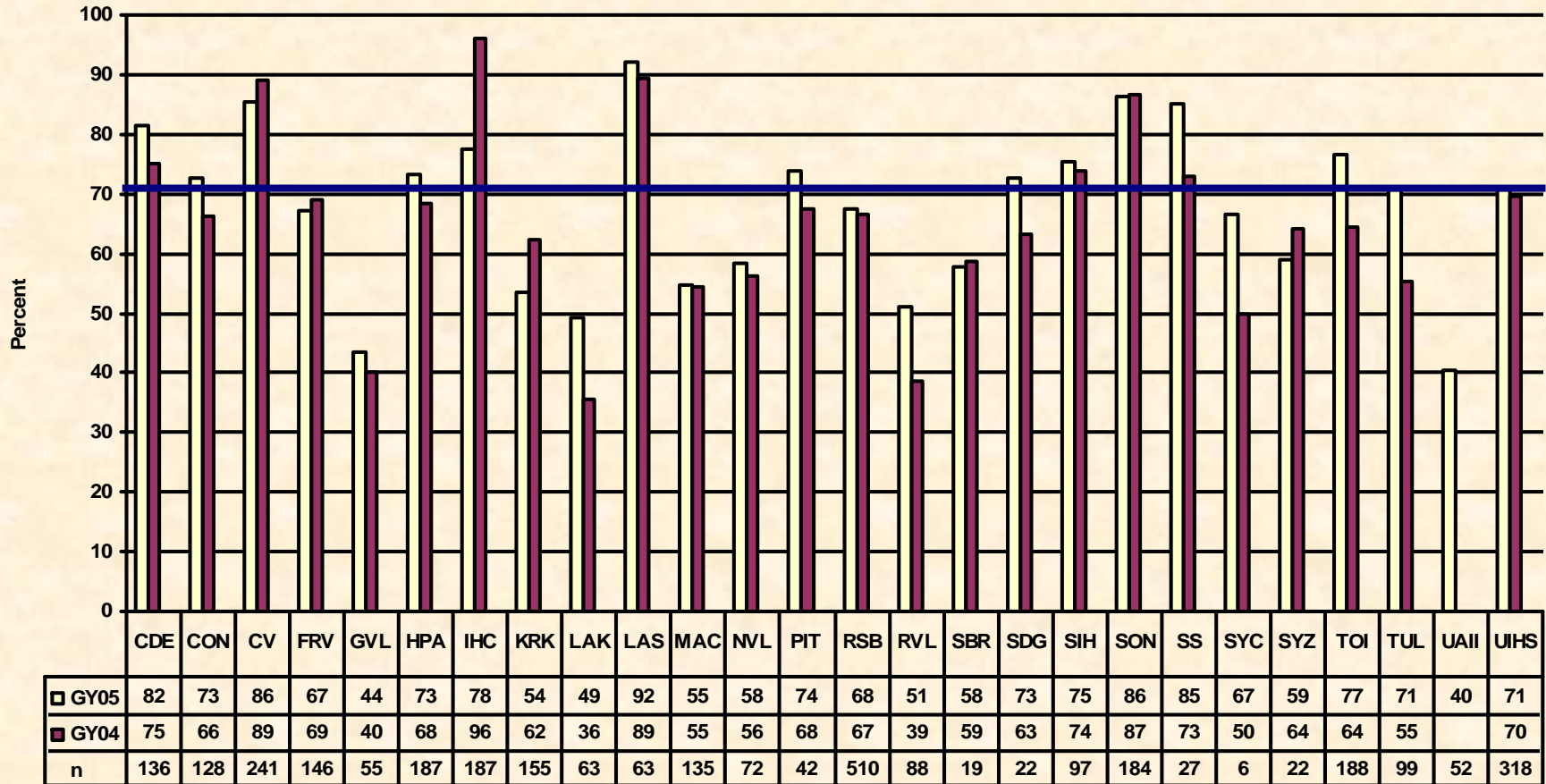

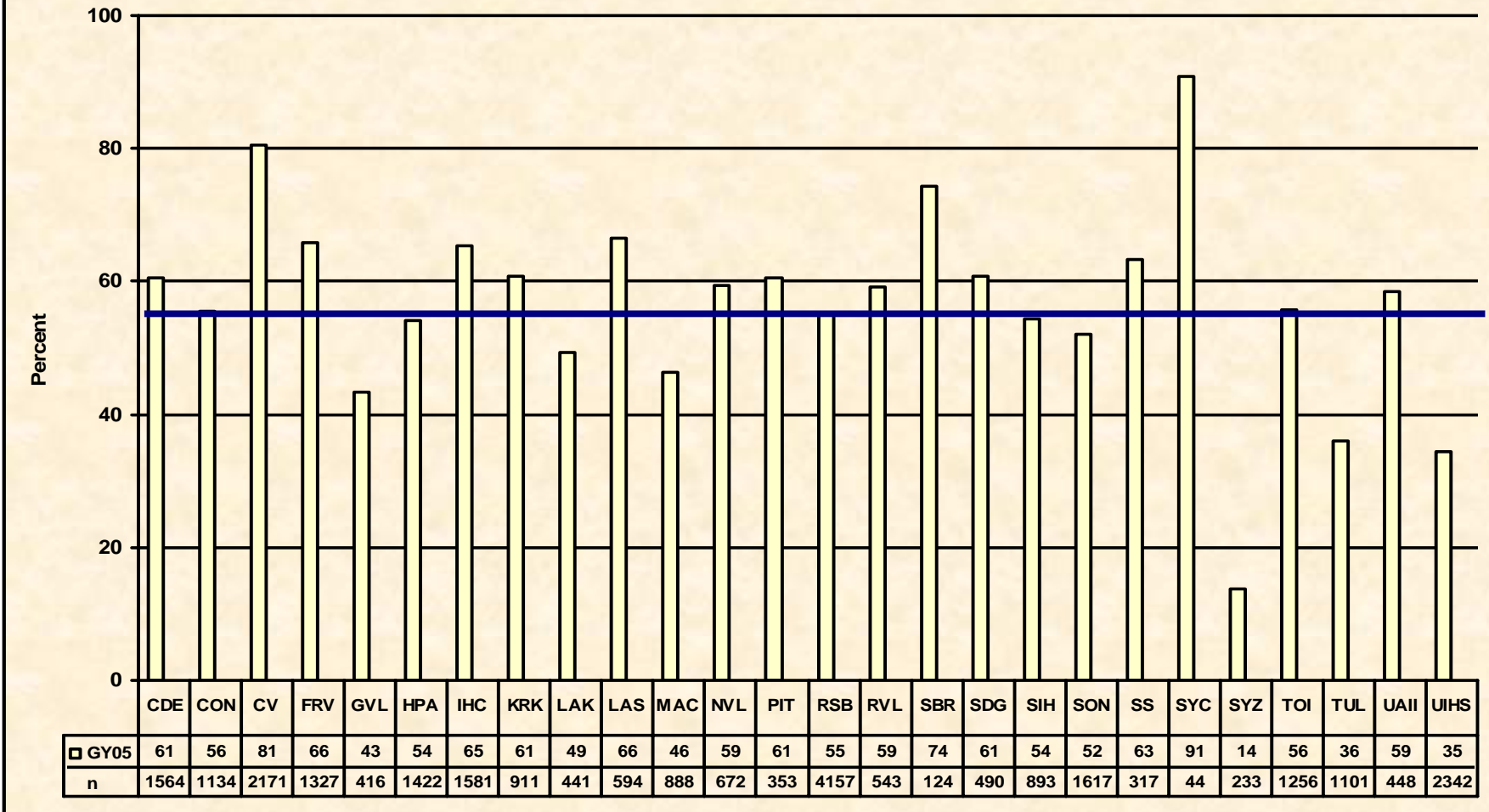
California Area Comparison - GPRA 2005

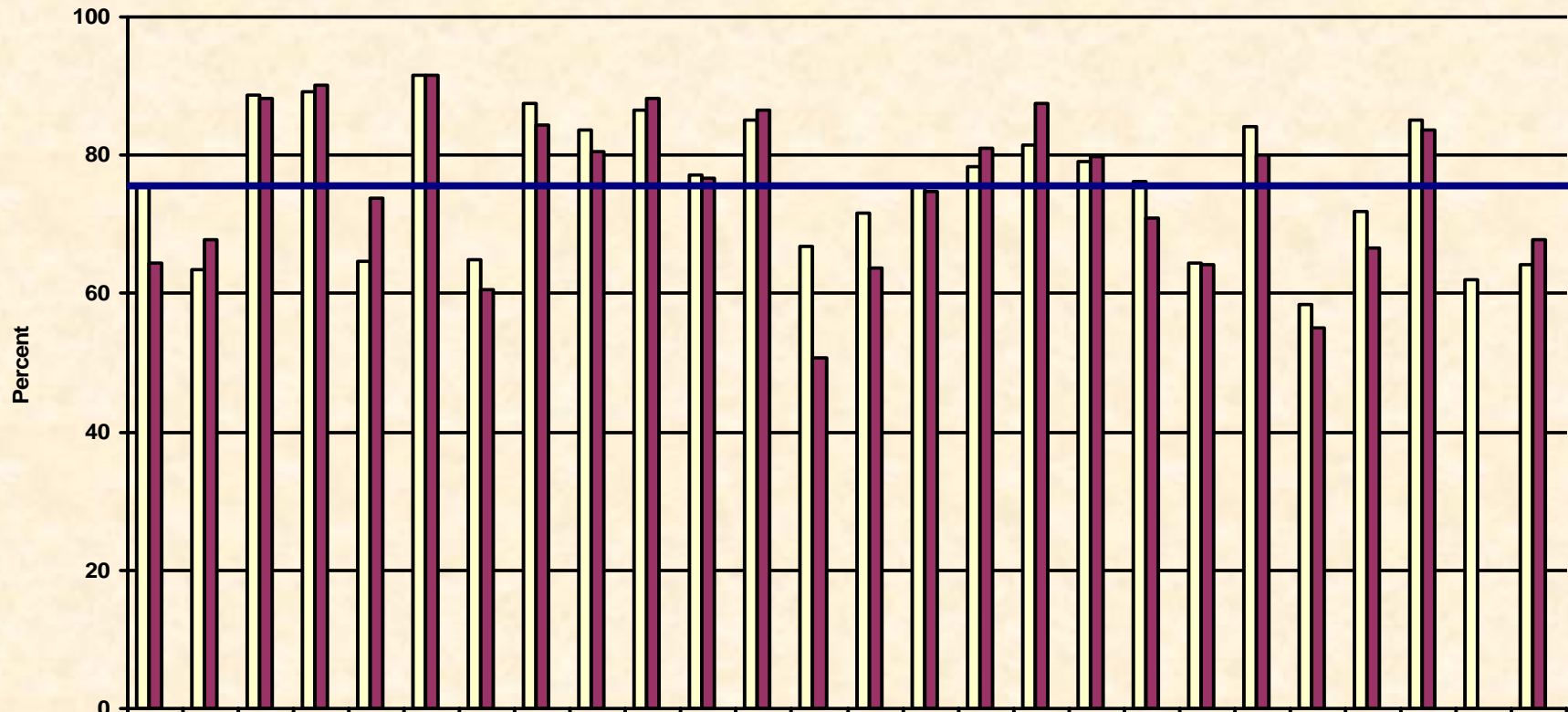

 Obesity Assessment (BMI Measurement)

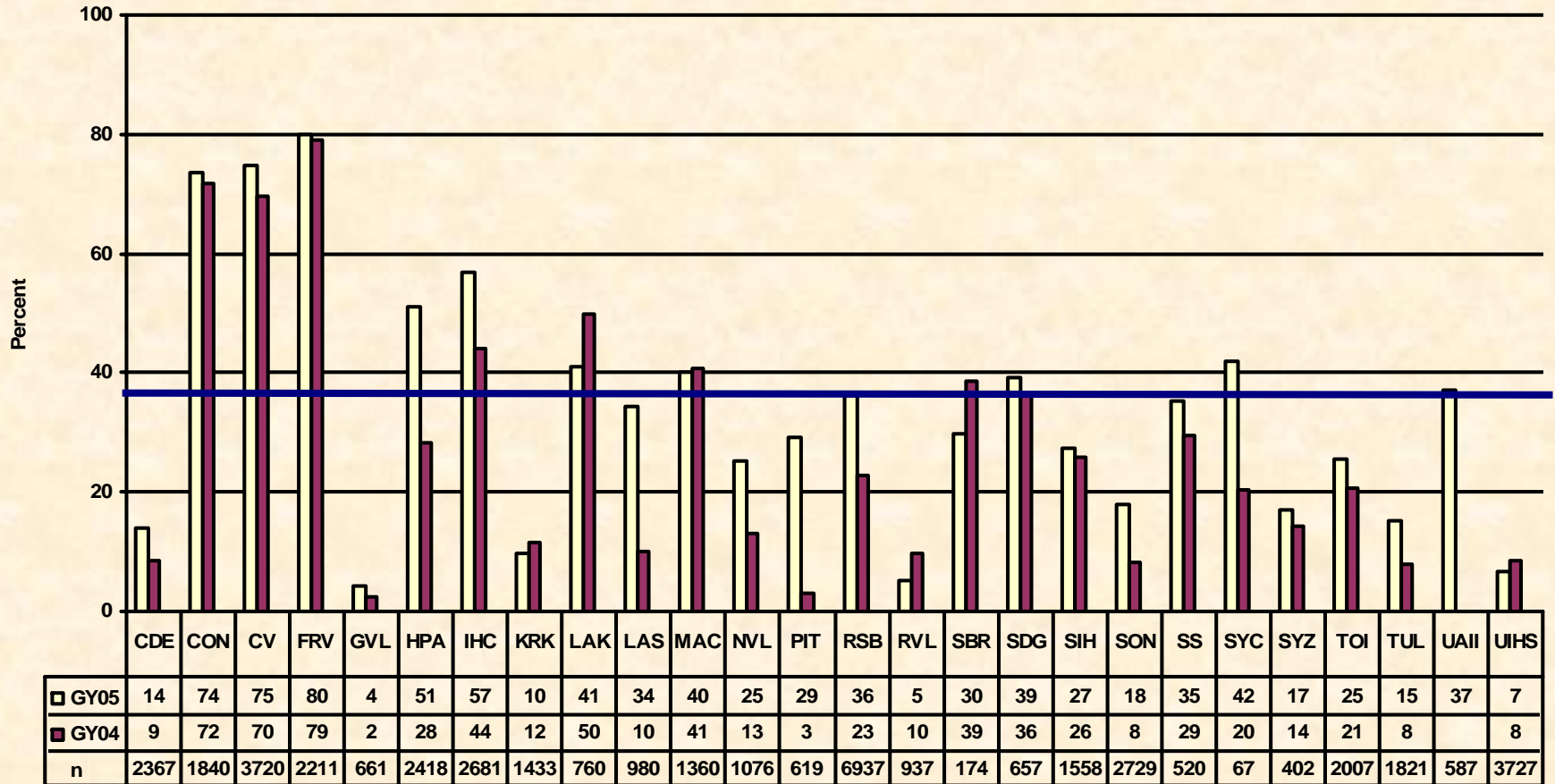
