- Bangor Property Bangor (Butte County) 15 acres
 - 18 miles South of Oroville
 - CATAC viewed this site on December 4, 2007
 - Failed in April, 2008 due to inadequate access to property


- HONEYROCK Property Oroville (Butte County) 32 acres
 - First choice
 - 67 miles from Sacramento Airport
 - Southeast of Oroville, in a residential setting
 - Existing stone lodge building (circa. 1931)
 - Outstanding community and county support
 - Site access on paved rural road
 - Utilities are on site
 - CATAC viewed this site on December 2, 2008

• **HONEYROCK** Property – (Continued)

- "Offer to Sell" at \$1,250,000 signed December 6, 2008
- IHS agreed to September 2, 2009 due diligence completion
- First property appraisal was flawed
- Second property appraisal is underway
- Title search is in process
- Advanced Approval from Congress is pending
- Historic preservation research is pending
- Right-of-way is needed for two small adjacent properties

• **HONEYROCK** Property –(Continued)

- Due diligence components to be completed by consultant
 - Site survey Boundary verification
 - Geotechnical study Soils
 - Topographic survey
 - Environmental Assessment
 - Archeological survey
 - Historic preservation requirements
 - Facility condition and usability study
 - Opportunities for renewable energy
- Scheduled completion August 20, 2009









MARR Property – Oroville (Butte County)

- Second choice
- 65 miles from Sacramento Airport
- Southern boundary of Oroville, in a rural setting
- Appraised at \$832,000
- Adjacent to cemetery and Southern Pacific rail yard
- Outstanding local and county support
- Site access on paved two-lane rural highway
- Utilities are nearby
- CATAC viewed site on June 17, 2008










- **Highway 70** Property Oak Grove (Butte County) 20 acres
 - Third choice
 - 60 miles from Sacramento Airport
 - 5 miles south of Oroville, in a rural setting
 - Outstanding local and county support
 - Site access on paved state highway
 - Utilities are nearby



- Wheatland Property Wheatland (Yuba) 21 acres
 - Fourth choice
 - 36 miles from Sacramento Airport
 - Near intersection of Hwy 65 and Hwy 70
 - County support
 - Site access on paved two-lane rural road and state highway
 - Utilities are nearby
 - Evidence of existing well



• **HEMET** Site; Palm Avenue (Riverside County)

20 acres

- Rural residential setting
- CATAC viewed this site on December 4, 2007
- Failed due to extensive development for roadway access
- ANZA Site, Cary Road (Riverside County)

- 82 miles from Ontario Airport
 46 miles from Palm Springs Airport
- Rural residential setting
- Strong support from Riverside County Planning
- Anza community meeting November 12 was positive
- Failed because Owner/Broker 'Offer to Sell' far exceeded documented property value


Expanded Property Search

- New brokers searched Southern California for new and recent listings
- Staff previewed and rejected three additional sites in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties in August and September 2008
- 3. Staff previewed 22 sites in December 2008 and January 2009
- 4. Site Selection Team ranked 5 from 10 sites visited in February 2009

- Expanded Property Search Ranked #1
 - LIVE OAK CANYON ROAD, Redlands (San Bernardino County)
 - 42 miles from Palm Springs Airport
 32 miles from Ontario Airport
 - 17.8 acres with 6± buildable acres, up to steep slopes
 - Large ranch and agricultural land
 - Electric power is on site
 - Existing well with 10,000 gallon tank and 6" water line
 - No septic
 - Adjacent to paved two-lane rural road




LIVE OAK CANYON ROAD, Redlands



- Expanded Property Search Ranked #2
 - TRIPP FLATS ROAD, Anza (Riverside County)
 - Adjacent to TRINITY ANZA
 - 50 miles from Palm Springs Airport;
 89 miles from Ontario Airport
 - 76.24 acres with 8± buildable acres, up to steep slopes
 - Electric power is on site
 - Existing well, no septic
 - Up to .8 mile all-weather unpaved county road









Expanded Property Search – Ranked #3

- TAYLOR RANCH, Sage Road, Hemet (Riverside County)
 - 61 miles from Palm Springs Airport
 76 miles from Ontario Airport
 - 20 acres, nearly level, very clean ranch property
 - Electric power is on site
 - Four existing wells, two septic systems
 - Paved road is .5 mile away along graded easement










YRTC Site Selection Current Status - South

Expanded Property Search – Ranked #4

- SAGE ROAD at Stanley, Hemet (Riverside County)
 - 63 miles from Palm Springs Airport
 78 miles from Ontario Airport
 - 20 acres, rolling hills among rural ranches and open range
 - Electric power is at the highway
 - No existing wells or septic
 - Paved two-lane county highway immediately adjacent






SAGE at Stanley, Hemet



YRTC Site Selection Current Status - South

- Expanded Property Search Ranked #5
 - BAUTISTA Road, Anza (Riverside County)
 - 46 miles from Palm Springs Airport
 89 miles from Ontario Airport
 - 13.7 acres, level rural ranch land
 - Electric power is adjacent
 - No existing wells or septic on site
 - Paved two-lane road immediately adjacent

YRTC Site Selection

Site Selection Criteria

- IHS Technical Handbook
 - Topography: Less than 15% slope
 - Water table: Not in wetland or flood plane
 - Soil conditions: Suitable for foundation; not seismically active
 - Historical significance: No historical or archaeological sites
 - Environmental hazards: No hazardous materials or previous contamination
 - Utilities: Community water, sewer and power available
 - Zoning: Zoned for intended purpose
 - Noise: Not in or adjacent to a commercial or industrial area
 - Fire protection: Full-time fire department available

YRTC Site Selection

- YRTC Network Task force recommendations
 - Location: Near a suburban/metropolitan area
 - Transportation: An airport with scheduled airline service within 50 miles
 - Reduce runaway risk: Not next to a freeway or railroad
 - Emergency hospital services/acute psychiatric care: Within 10 miles
