Enclosed you will find a copy of Fort McHenry's fee waiver application. Please fill out the application and return it with the following documentation:

A letter submitted on official school letterhead, signed by the principal, and stating that "the visit is for educational purposes and related to the current curriculum." Any further relevant information and/or lesson plans relating to the visit may be included in this letter.

For homeschools, the letter can be signed by a spokesperson for the group and must include documentation that shows that the homeschool is recognized as an official educational institution.

Please send all information to the attention of the Fee Waiver Coordinator at the address at the top of this page. It must be postmarked at least three weeks prior to the scheduled visit, or it can be faxed two weeks prior to the visit. Your request will be reviewed, and the waiver application will be returned to you once it is approved or denied.

Failure to provide adequate and definitive documentation or failure to send the application on time will result in denial of the waiver request. Any group visiting without an approved fee waiver will be charged the regular adult entrance fee of \$7.00 for each adult.
