The historic fort was not designed for visitation reaching 700,000 annually. High walls, numerous cannon, and sloped, unmowed earthworks are potentially dangerous if climbed on.

Chaperones and leaders are reminded to stay with their groups at all times and enforce safety rules.

While visiting the Star Fort, please keep your groups on the brick walkways and please observe the following safety regulations:

- No climbing on cannons, walls, and earthworks
- No horseplay and running in and around the fort
- No jumping off walls

Park rules and Federal regulations are enforced by park rangers. Help protect this national treasure and the members of your group.
