Heavy rain caused rises in creeks. A few roads were covered by water but not closed. In Crittenden County, water rose to the edges of Kentucky 120 and Kentucky 855 at mile marker 5. In Caldwell County, water was over Highway 91 just north of Fredonia and Highway 641 just south of Fredonia. Some water was over roads in Webster County. Rainfall amounts for the 48-hour period ending at 7 A.M. on the 28th ranged up to 3.48 inches in Providence (Webster County). This report was from a co-operative observer.

Heavy rain over far western Kentucky caused some flooding, prompting a few road closures. In Carlisle County, Kentucky 1628 and Kentucky 1820 were both closed at bridges crossing Wilson Creek. In Lyon County, Kentucky 819 was closed at mile marker 6, and Kentucky 1943 was closed at mile marker 3. The 48-hour rainfall for the period ending at 7 A.M. on the 28th was 2.76 inches at Paducah.

Heavy rain over southeast Missouri caused some minor road flooding. In northern Stoddard County, roads began to cover with some water, but no closures were reported. Minor street flooding occurred in Cape Girardeau and surrounding areas. Rainfall amounts for the 48-hour period ending at 7 A.M. on the 28th included 2.38 inches at Bernie (Stoddard County) and 1.82 inches at Cape Girardeau.
