## MOBILETEL, INC. PETITION FOR PARTIAL WAIVER

## PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED

CC Docket No. 96-45

In the May 8, 1997 *Universal Service Report and Order*, the Commission directed all interstate telecommunications carriers, payphone providers, and others which provide interstate telecommunications service for a fee to contribute to the Universal Service Funds.<sup>1</sup> Cellular, paging, and mobile radio telecommunications service are specifically identified by the Commission and the Joint Board as examples of interstate telecommunications.<sup>2</sup> Contributions to the universal service support mechanisms must be based on contributors' end-user telecommunications revenues from the previous year.<sup>3</sup> MobileTel, Inc.'s 1997 and 1998 revenues include revenue from cellular telecommunications service provided to certain rural service areas in Louisiana. On May 27, 1998, MobileTel, Inc. filed a petition seeking to exclude these revenues from its 1998 and 1999 Universal Service contribution bases respectively because, in December 1997, the

Commission awarded the Block B cellular licenses for those markets to other service providers, which began providing service and collecting revenues therefor in March 1998.

Parties wishing to comment on MobileTel's Request for Waiver are directed to file the comments on or before **June 23, 1998**, to file reply comments on or before **June 30, 1998**, in accordance with the procedures set forth below.
