







## Guangdong: Increasing attention towards environmental protection

Guangdong Province's increased enforcement of pollution prevention, energy efficiency and clean technology production is driving growth in the province's environmental sector. In recent years, the provincial government has placed an increasing amount of importance on environmental protection through the creation and implementation of a wide range of environmental protection programs. These have tended to focus on alleviating water/air pollution and enforcement of environmental controls on river valleys and various regions. From 2008 through 2010, Guangdong province plans to allocate around 29 billion USD for environmental protection.



### **Opportunities and Trends**

- ♣ Guangdong plans to build 94 new wastewater treatment plants by 2010, which when combined with the 159 plants already in operation will reach a daily capacity of 14million tons per day.
- By 2010, Guangdong plans to build 7 industrial waste treatment centers, 30 municipal waste treatment centers, 3 hazardous waste treatment centers, 8 medical waste treatment centers, 3 electronic waste treatment centers, a municipal sludge treatment center, and a restaurant waste treatment center.
- ♣ More Flue Gas Desulfurization (FGD) projects and environmental early warning systems have been included in the next provincial five year plan (2010-2015).
