Heavy rainfall resulted in flooding along Highway 185 just south of Victoria. Radar estimated 2 to 3 inches of rain fell across southern portions of Victoria county.

Nueces County

Corpus Christi

Slow moving and training thunderstorms resulted in flooding across areas of Corpus Christi. Several city streets, intersections and underpasses were flooded. The slick roadways contributed to several accidents throughout the city. A portion of the Crosstown Expressway, from S.P.I.D. to Gollihar, was closed and impassable with up to 2 feet of water covering the roadway. Radar estimated widespread 2 to 4 inches of rain fell, with isolated areas of 5 to 8 inches, across central sections of Corpus Christi and up into Portland. 6.1 inches of rain was reported by a spotter on Brawner Parkway and 7.6 inches was reported by the public off of Kostoryz and Gollihar.

Heavy rainfall resulted in a few city streets and low water crossings in Kingsville flooded briefly. In addition, law enforcement reported flooding along several Farm to Market roads just northwest of Loyola Beach. Radar estimated 2 to 4 inches of rain fell quickly between U.S. 77 and Baffin Bay.

Slow moving and training thunderstorms produced very heavy rainfall across Nueces and San Patricio counties. Widespread flooding of streets in Portland was reported. The North Shore Estates in Portland had over 3 feet of water over some streets. The Portland Police Department reported Memorial Creek flowing over Broadshore, Northshore and the eastside of town. Radar estimated 2 to 4 inches of rain fell across this area, over already saturated grounds.

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Major street flooding occurred across Corpus Christi as a result of slow moving and training thunderstorms. Several city streets throughout central and south Corpus Christi were flooded. Radar estimated 2 to 4 inches of rain fell across this area of Corpus Christi. Spotters reported 4 inches of rain on Ocean Drive and 3 inches of rain in just 1 hour and 15 minutes at Kostoryz and Golihar.
