<u>Introductory Course Descriptions</u>:

The **Misuse of Position** course provides a broad overview of Subpart G and includes a four-step approach to determine whether proposed actions are prohibited by the misuse subpart.

The **How to Identify Disqualifying Financial Interests** course provides seven steps to identify disqualifying financial interests and serves as a "nuts and bolts" refresher on 18 U.S.C. § 208.

The **Post-Employment** course provides both an overview of the post-employment statute, 18 U.S.C. § 207, as well as a step-by-step methodology for analyzing post-employment situations.

All courses are offered **free of charge**. However, advance registration is required.
