



White Mountain National Forest Russell-Colbath Barn

The Russell-Colbath Barn, located at the Russell-Colbath Historic site, is available for rent for family gatherings, wedding receptions, or other community events.

The site is located in the Passaconaway Valley, on the north side of the Kancamagus Highway in Albany, NH.

Completed in 2003, this post and beam barn was a welcome addition to the Russell-Colbath Historic Site.

Adjacent to the barn is the Russell-Colbath Home, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, a Town of Albany cemetery, and the Rail N' River Trail. This easy walking trail is fairly flat, and accessible. Interpretive signs are placed along the trail. Walkers will learn about early logging activities in the valley.

Rental Fee:

Russell-Colbath Barn is \$50 per day (2006).

Capacity:

Limited to a maximum of 120 people.

Seasonal Availability:

The barn season is approximately Mid-May through Mid-October.

Amenities Available:

- Tables
- Chairs
- An electrical system runs from the generator to the barn, providing power for lighting and audio-visual equipment.
- Restrooms with flush toilets
- This site is fully ADA Accessible.



Specific Rules and Regulations:

- All doors in the barn must be latched open (not only unlocked, but completely open to the outside) when it is occupied, regardless of the number of people. This requirement must be followed to meet fire code.
- All refuse, waste, food, and any other materials associated with your use shall be removed from the site immediately following use of the barn. The barn must be left in the condition found.
- The barn is closed between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am.
- Alcohol is not permitted in the barn.
