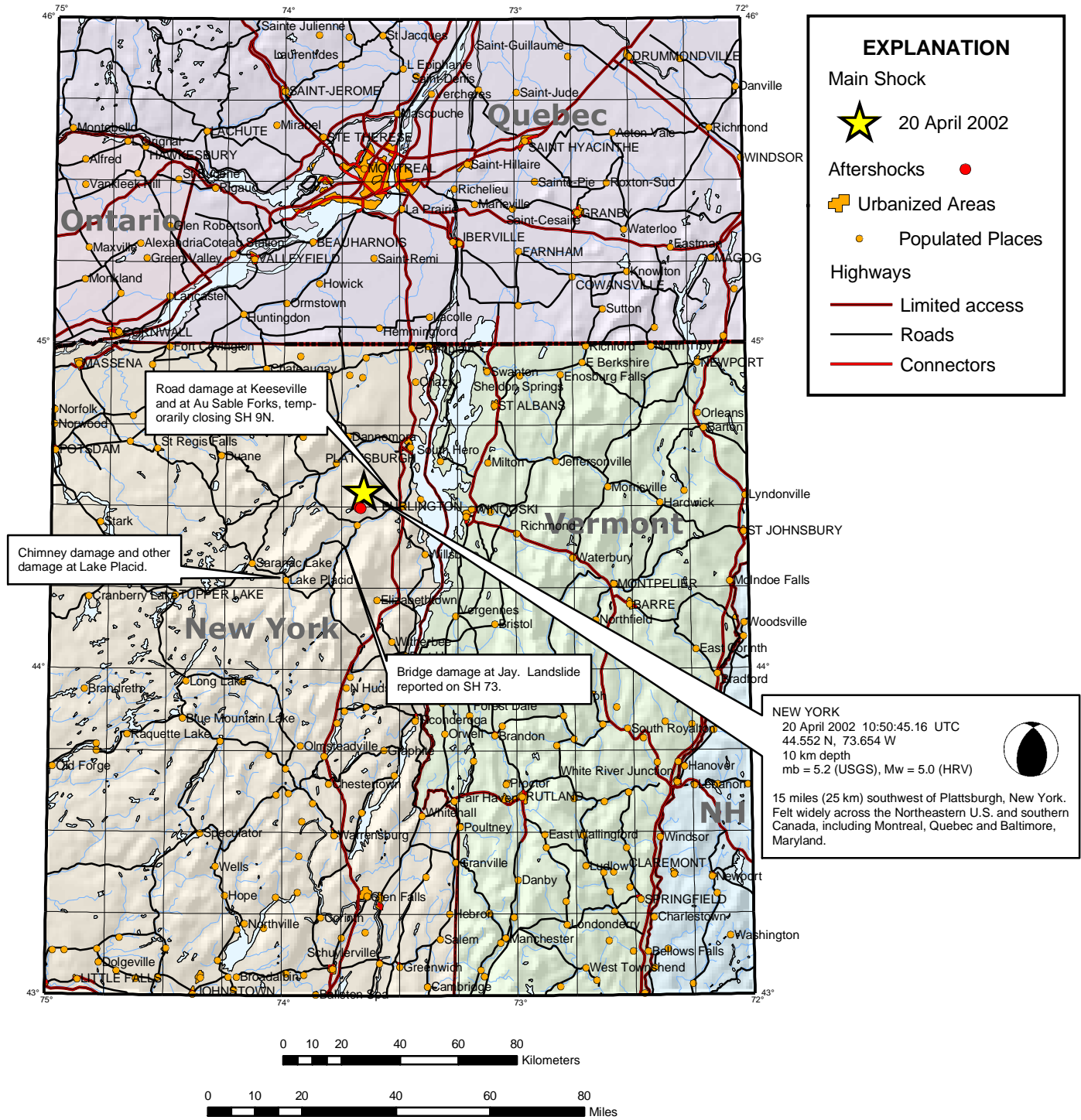


Plattsburgh, New York Earthquake of 20 April 2002



A moderate earthquake occurred about 15 miles southwest of Plattsburgh, New York at 6:50 AM EDT, Apr 20, 2002. Slight damage (MMI VI) reported at Blue Mountain Lake, Indian Lake, Minerva, and North River. Felt (MMI V) at Adirondack, Childwold, Moriah Center, Newcomb, North Creek, Old Forge, Olmstedville, Piercefield, Severance, Wanakena, and many other localities of upstate New York. This earthquake was about the same size as the Blue Mountain Lake earthquake on October 7, 1983.
