Nature of bill: Extension of temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2011.

1,2-Benzenedicarboxaldehyde (CAS No. 643-79-8) (provided for in subheading 2912.29.60).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject product is a chemical sterilant that has been approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for use in applications such as cold instrument sterilization. Cold sterilization is critical for instruments that cannot be disinfected in an autoclave, such as endoscopes. The product is imported from Austria.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 1,2-BENZENEDICARBOXALDEHYDE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.92 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 1,2-Benzenedicarboxaldehyde) is amended by striking the
7 date in the effective period column and inserting “12/31/
8 2011”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
